DESCRIPTION

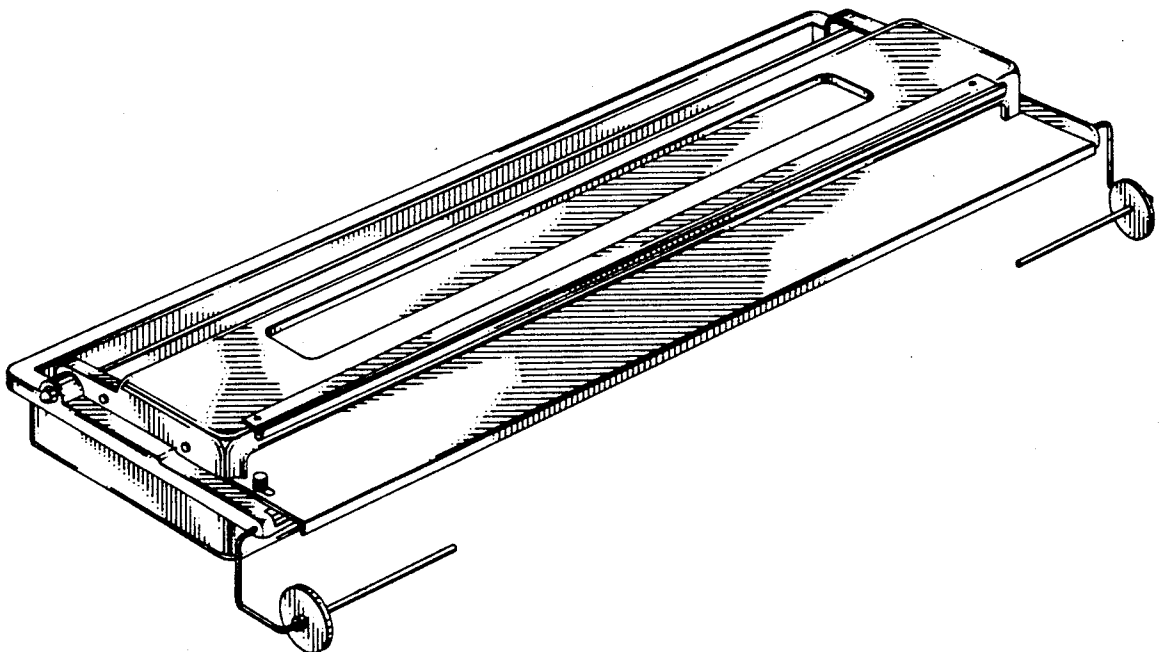
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wallpaper pasting machine showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view with portions of the article broken away for convenience of illustration thereof.



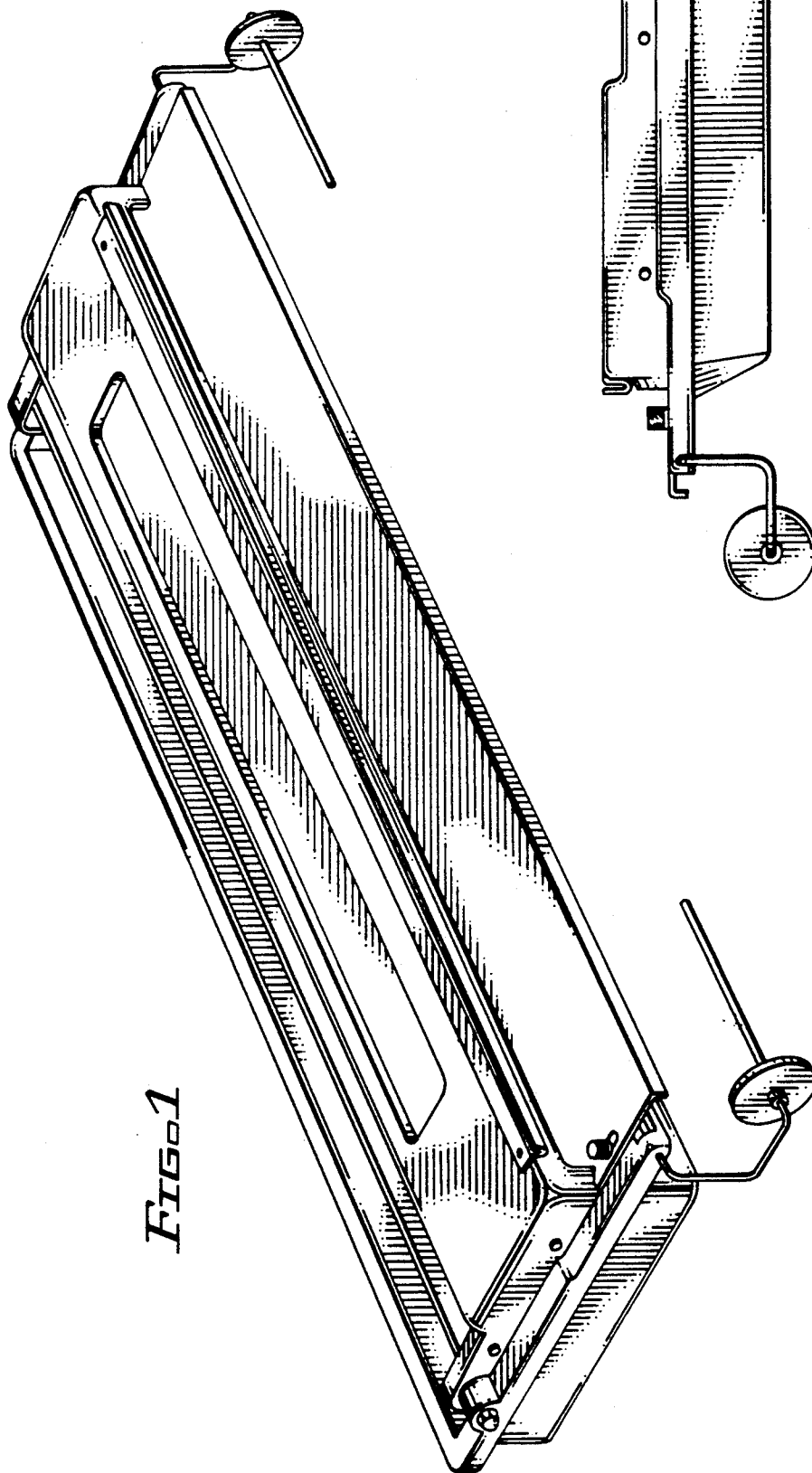

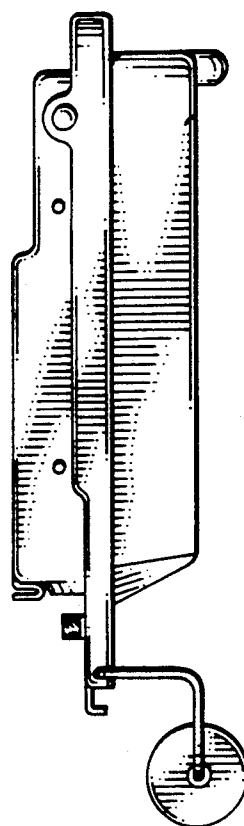
