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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fishing lure, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a fishing lure showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one side of the embodiment depicted in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the other side of the embodiment depicted in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment depicted in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is an elevational front view of the embodiment depicted in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is an elevational rear view thereof.

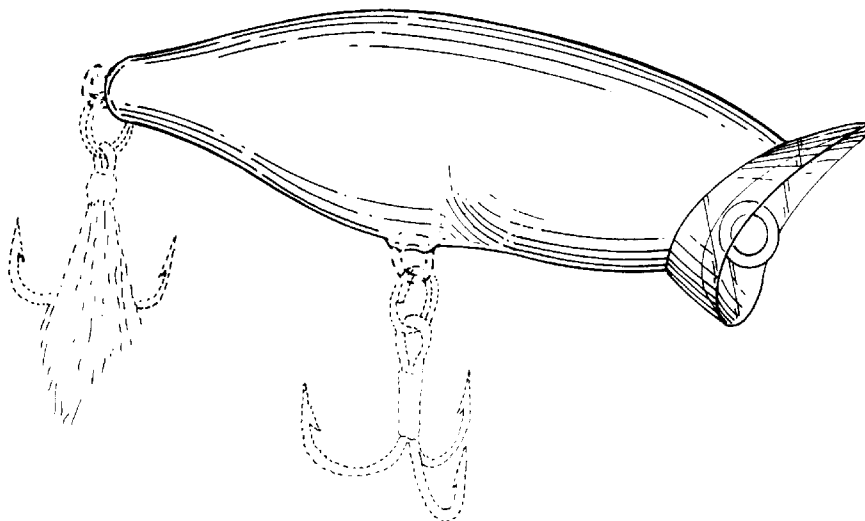

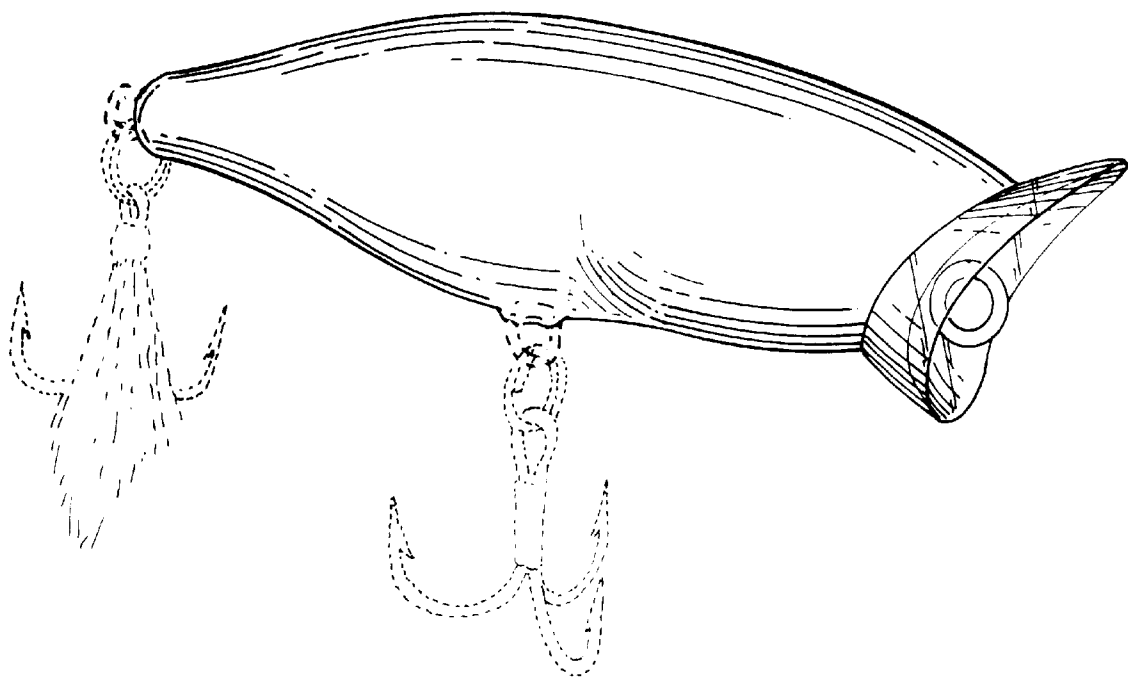

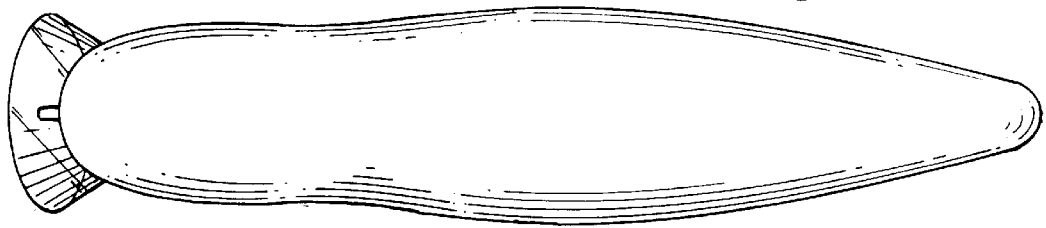

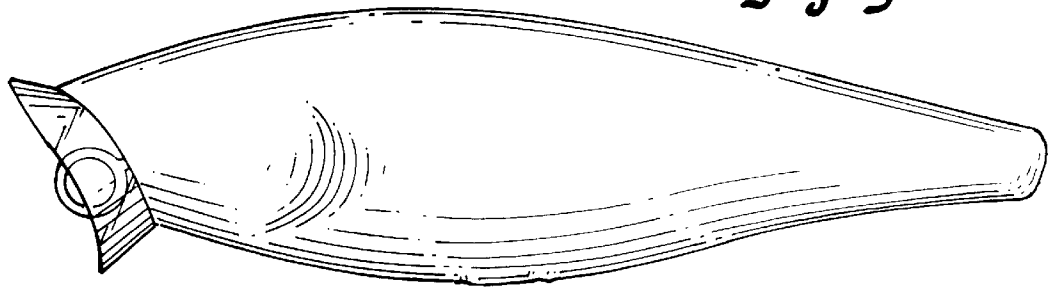

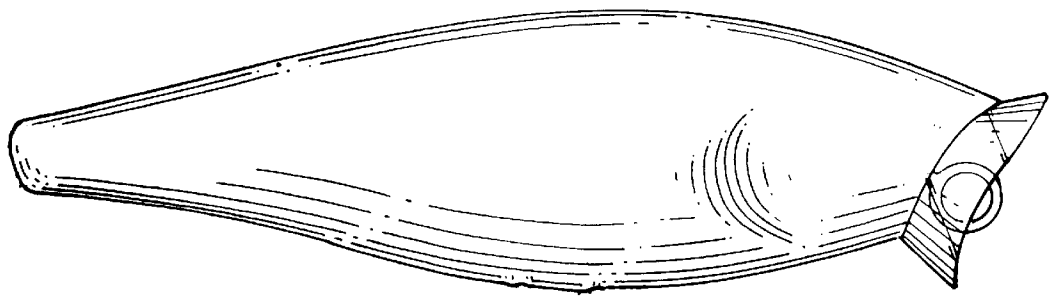

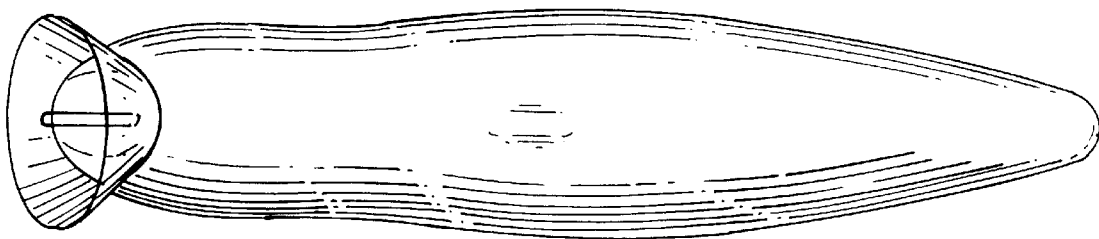

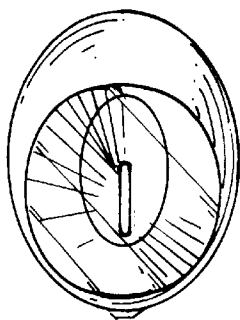
