




To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, RAIDER S. WICKS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Seattle, in the county of King and State of Washington, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Automobile-Tires, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a view of the tread surface of a section of a tire.

Fig. 2 is a side view of a section of a tire.

Fig. 3 is a cross section, taken through the line of depression in the tire tread.
