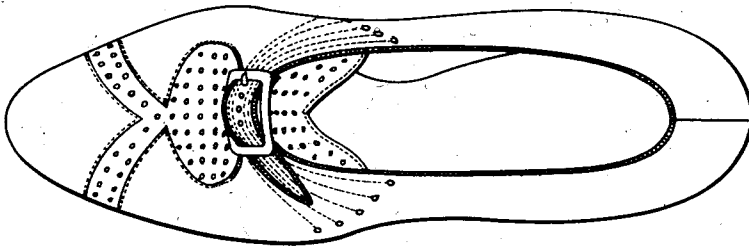
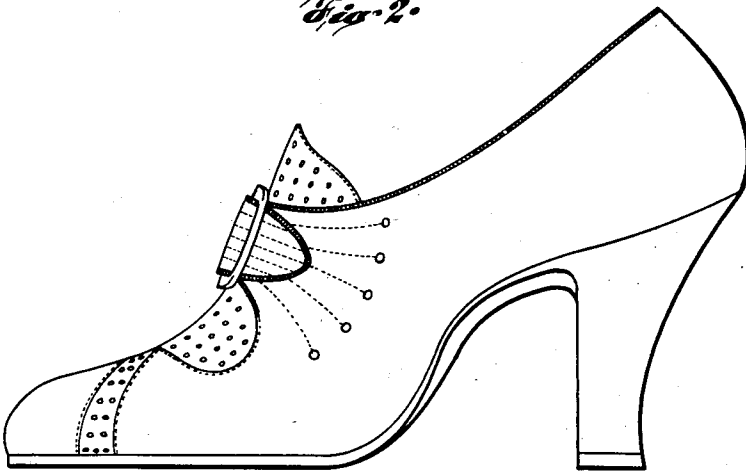

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John J. Walsh, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of Maplewood, county of St. Louis, State of Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing, Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a shoe showing my new design; and Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the same.
