

## DESIGN FOR A FLASHLIGHT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Rodger F. Becker, a citizen of the United States, residing in Kalamazoo, county of Kalamazoo, State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Flashlight, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side plan view of a flashlight embodying my new design.

Figure 2 is a fragmentary view of the upper end of the battery case of said flashlight as appearing in Figure 1 and taken from the rightward side thereof. I claim:

The ornamental design for a flashlight, substantially as shown.
