

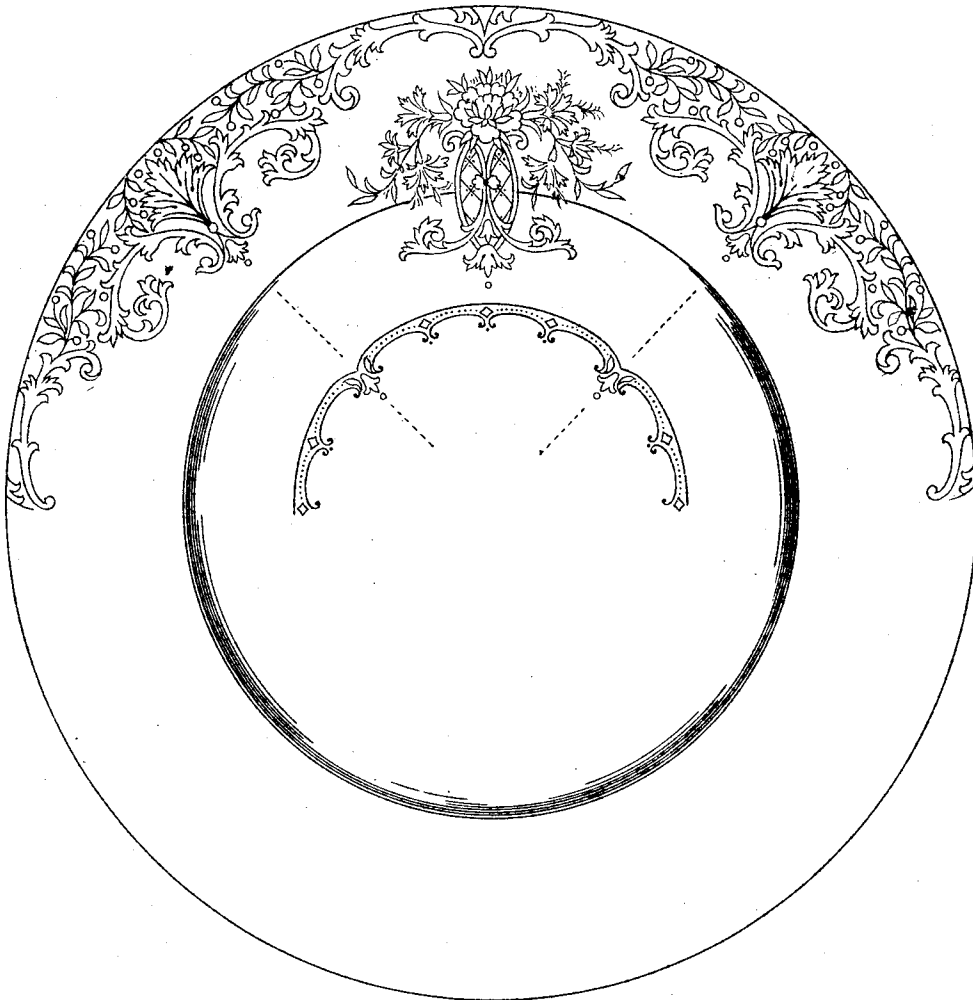

DESIGN FOR A PLATE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed January 6, 1931. Serial No. 38,227. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, URASABURO TOMITA, a subject of the Emperor of Japan, residing in Astoria, county of Queens, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Plate or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part hereof.

The drawing is a plan view of a plate show-

ing my new design, a repeat unit of which is contained between the dotted lines. Said unit is repeated about the plate in the relation indicated by the extension of the detailed showing beyond the dotted lines.
