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(57) **CLAIM**


I claim the ornamental design for a faucet, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right perspective view of another embodiment of the claimed design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.














