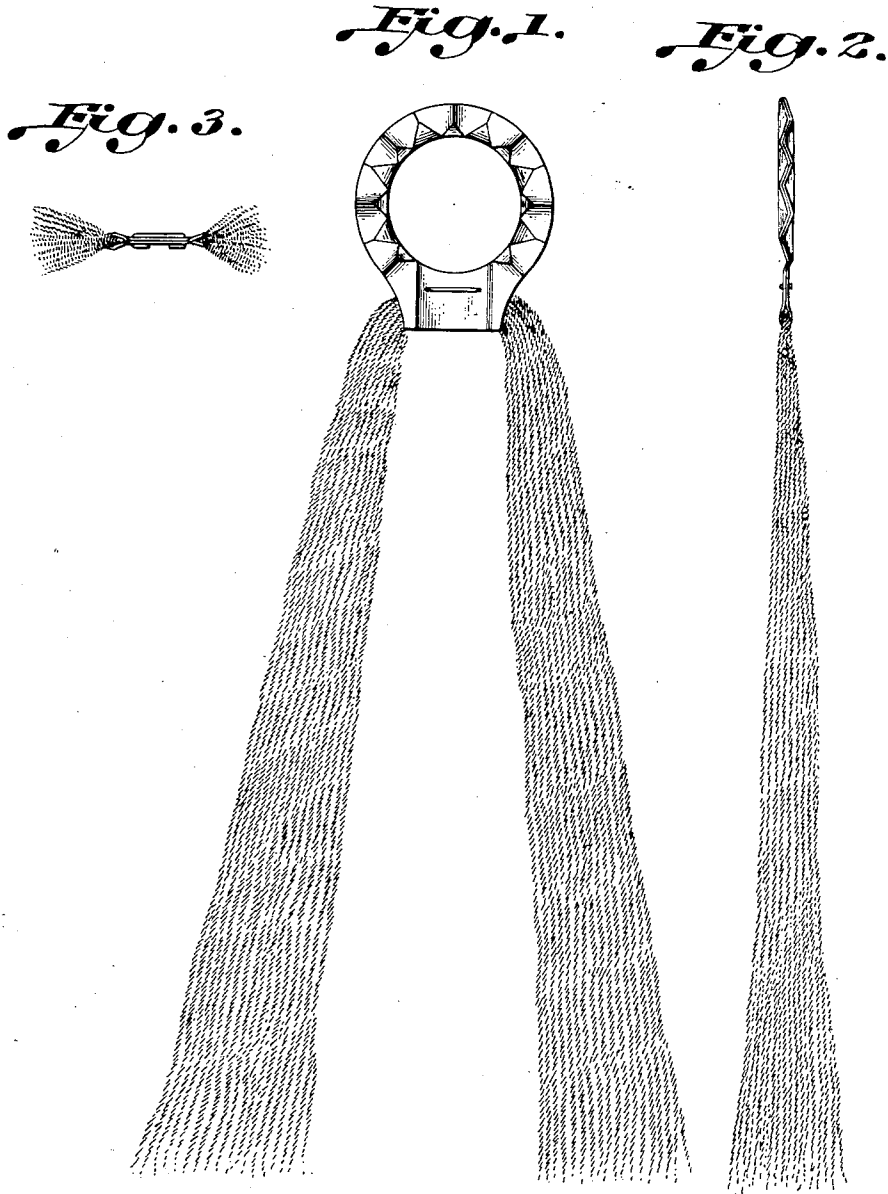

DESIGN FOR A CHRISTMAS TREE ORNAMENT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Philip Kranz and Albert P. Schmid, citizens of the United States of America, residing at Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Christmas Tree Ornament, of which the following is a specification reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a Christmas tree ornament, showing our new design.

Fig. 2 is an end elevation of Fig. 1.

Fig. 3 is a plan view of Fig. 1.
