

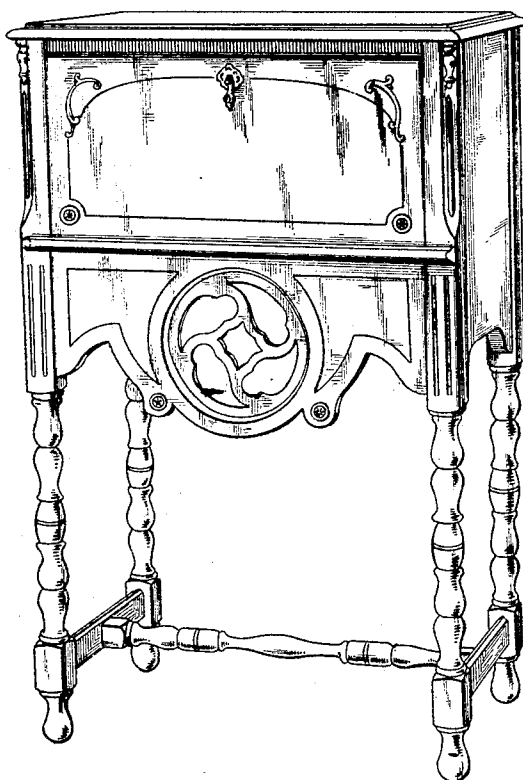

DESIGN FOR A RADIOCABINET OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.
