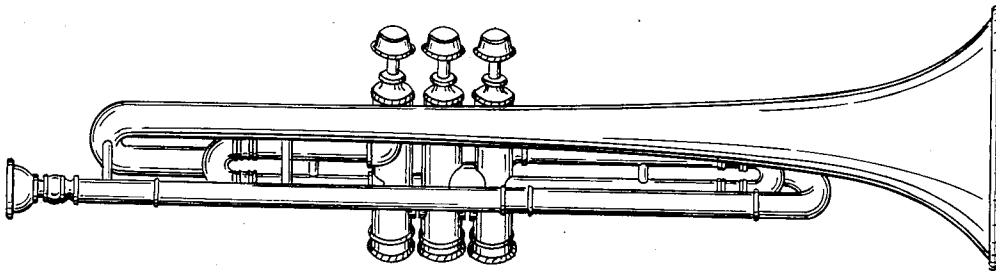

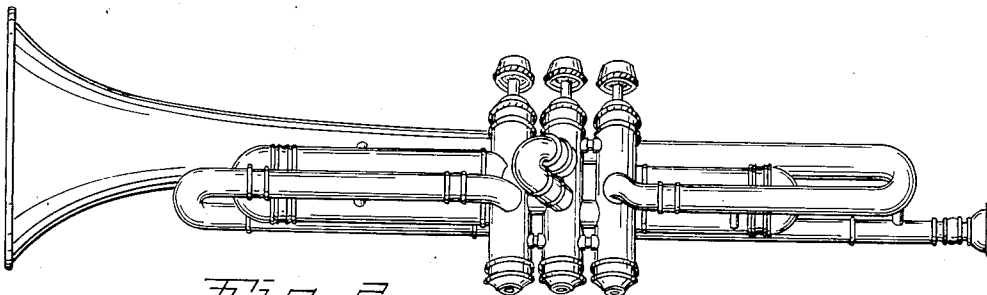

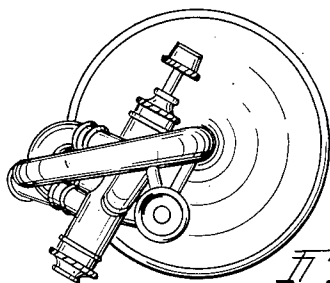

DESIGN FOR A TRUMPET OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Alfred J. Johnson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Grand Rapids, county of Kent, State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Trumpet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a trumpet or similar article, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the same,

taken from the side opposite that of Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is an end elevational view of the same, taken from the left end of Fig. 1.

The characteristic feature of my design resides in the angular disposition of the piston valve unit with respect to the coil of the fundamental tube of the trumpet substantially as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a trumpet or similar article, as shown and described.
