



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Cyril W. Leigh, a British subject, residing at East Orange, Essex County, State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dinner Plate or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

The sole figure is a plan view of a plate of conventional configuration, showing my new design. The dominant feature of the design resides in the floral ornamentation, shown on the plate.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a dinner plate or similar article, as shown and described.
