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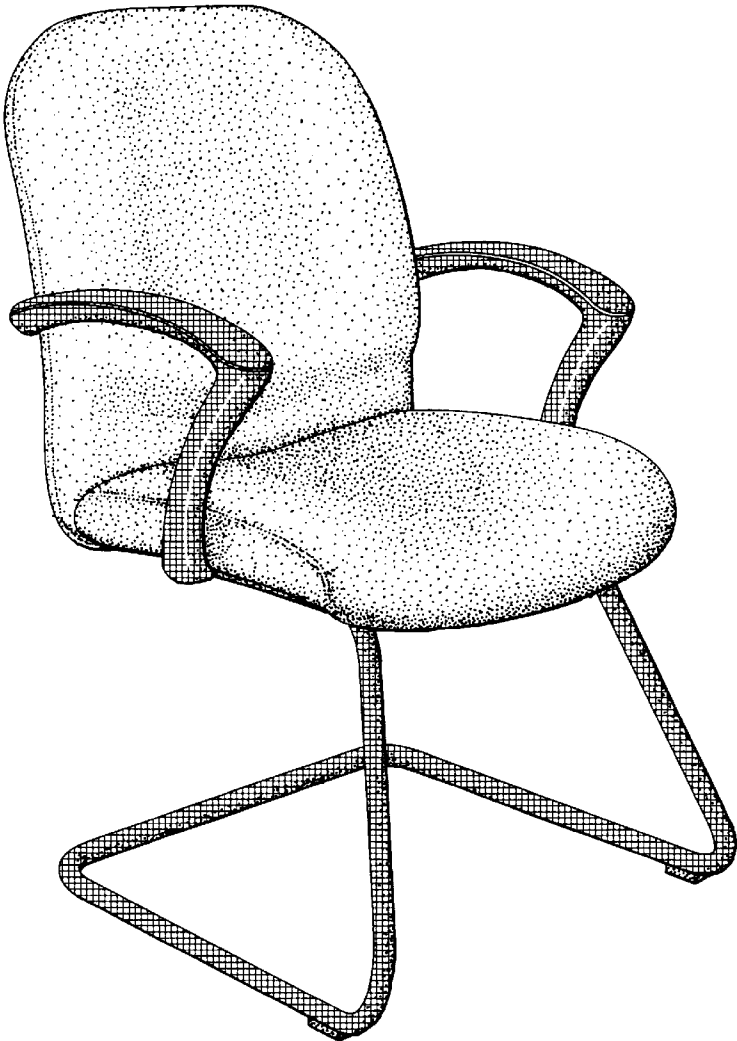

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front three-quarter perspective view of a chair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side perspective view thereof, the left side perspective view (not shown) being the mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear three quarter perspective view thereof.
The tubular support and armrest members have been lined for the color black.

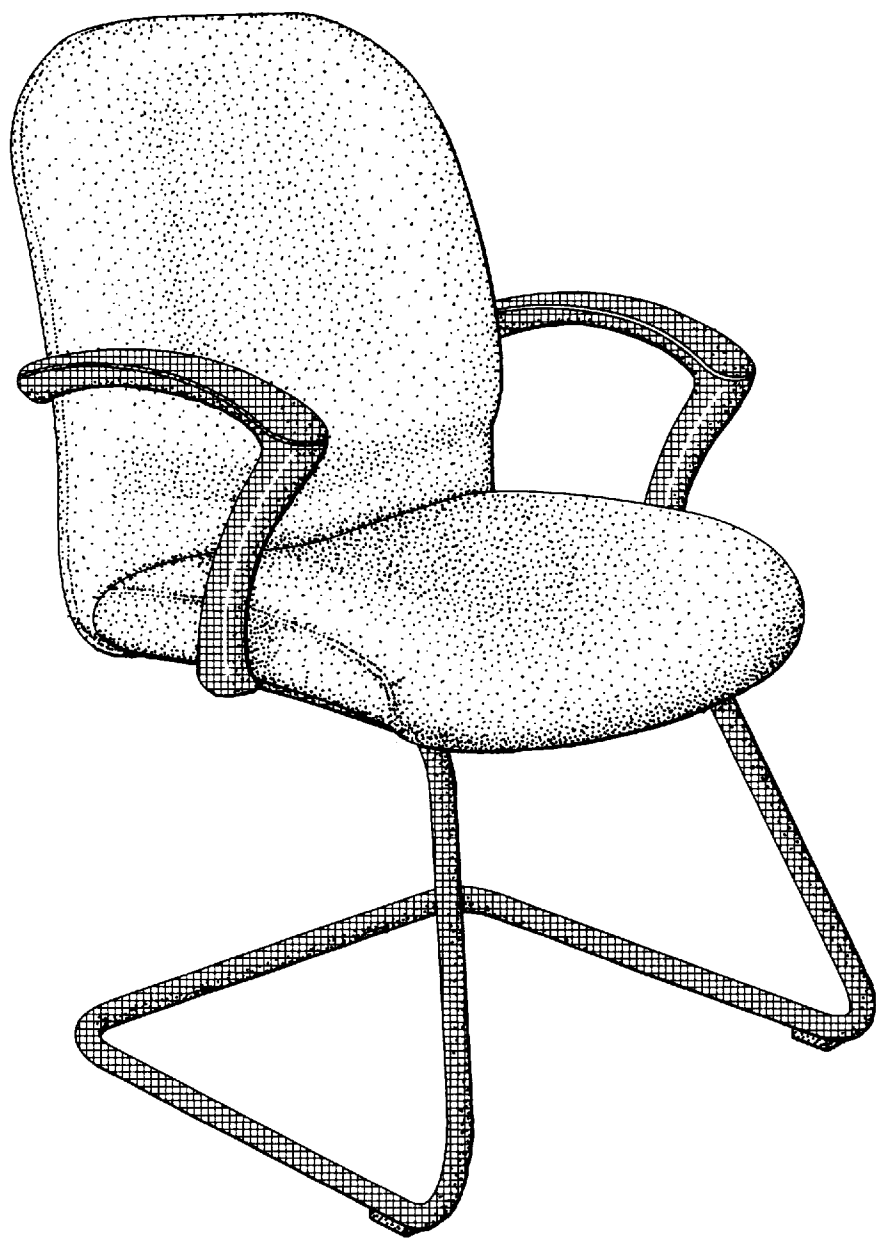

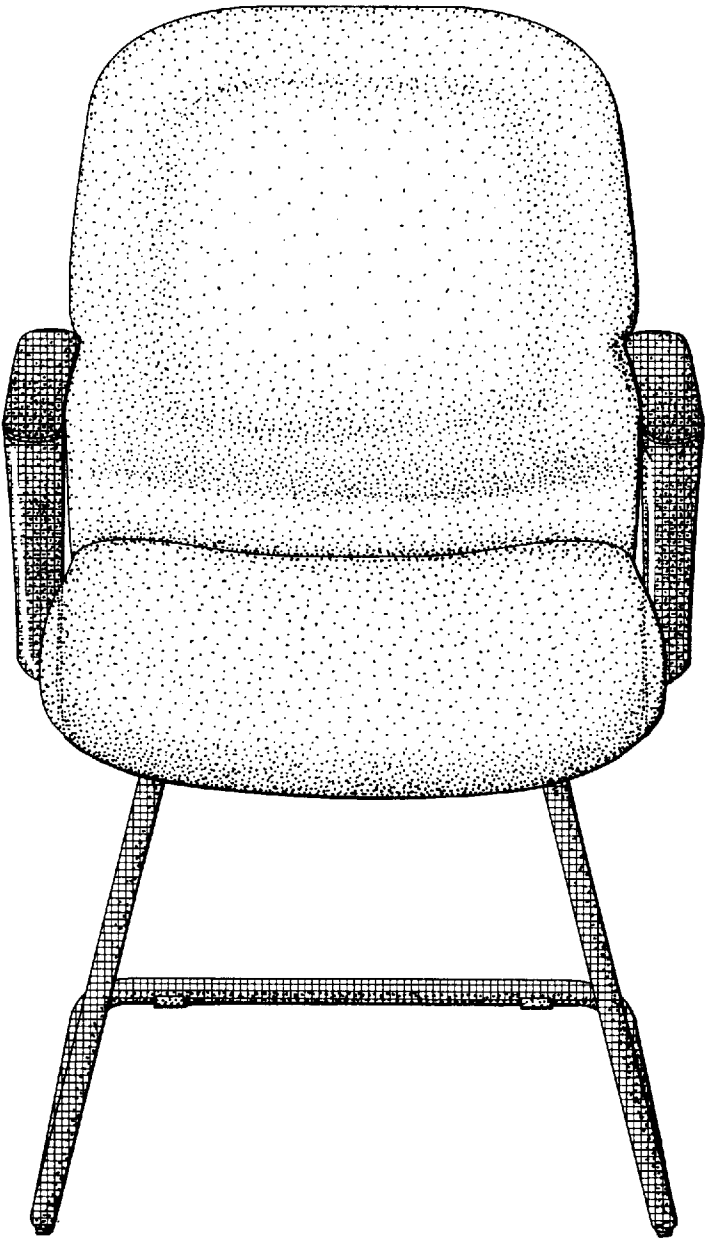

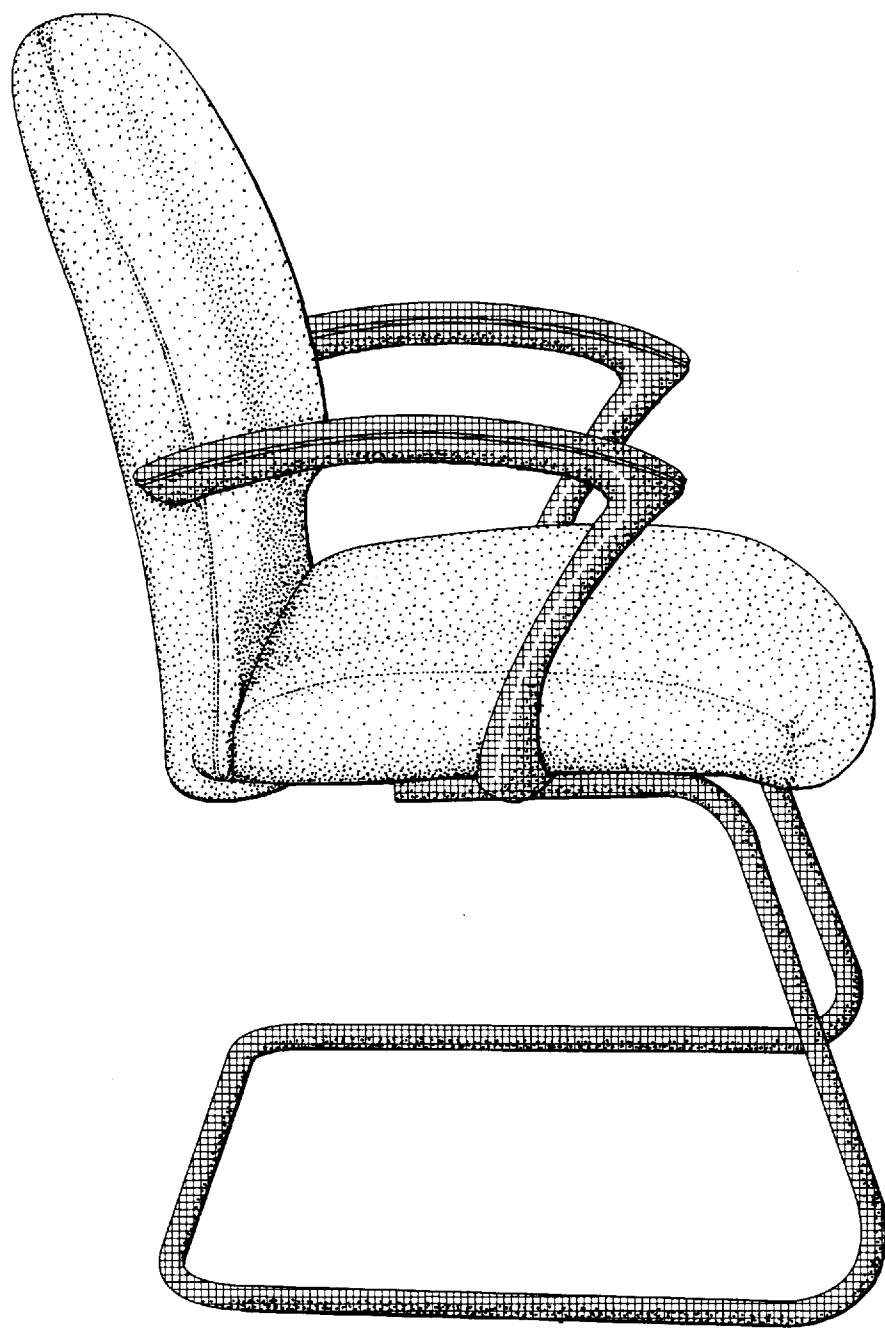

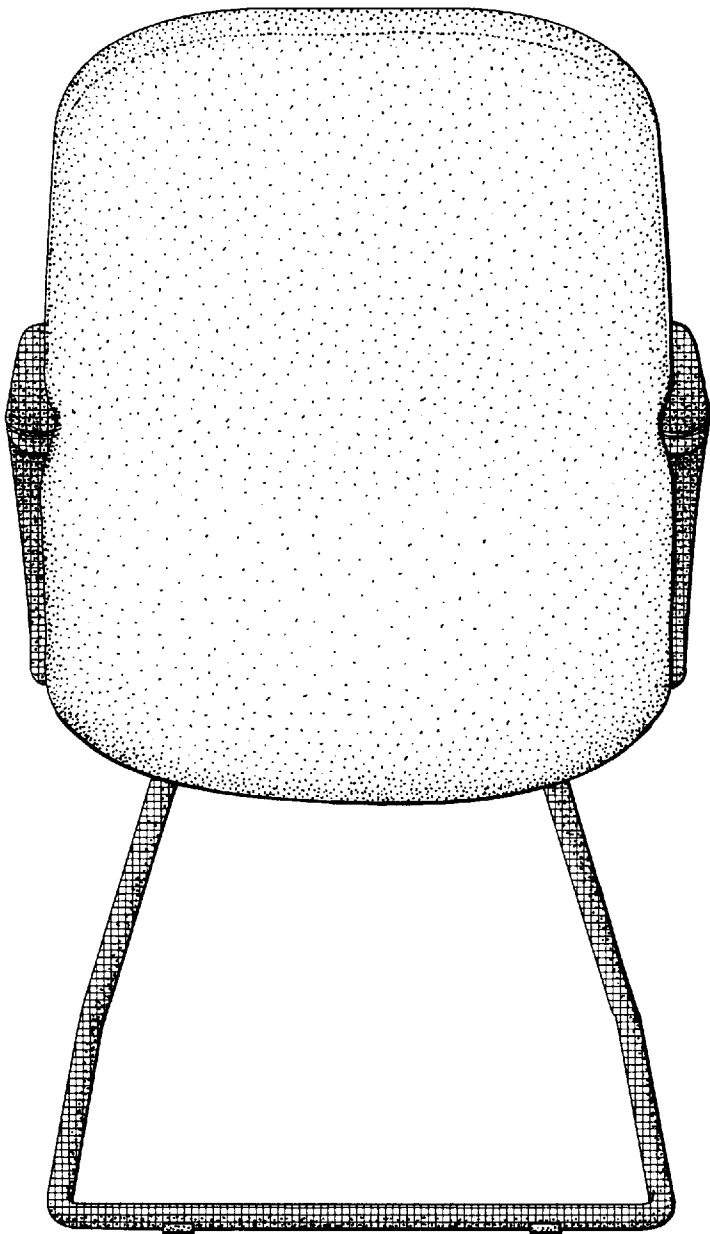

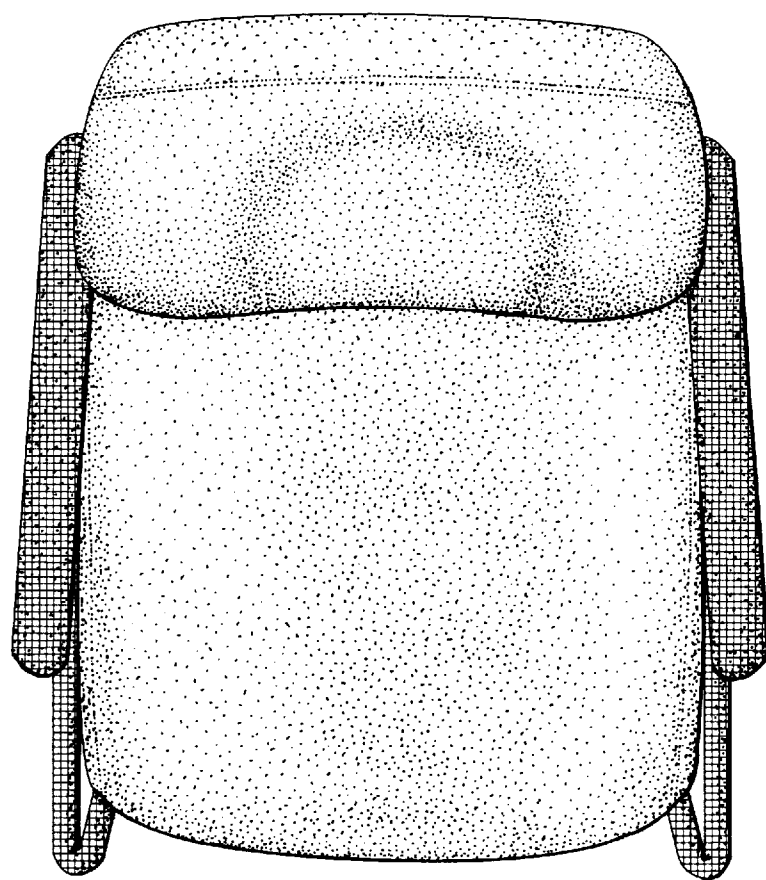

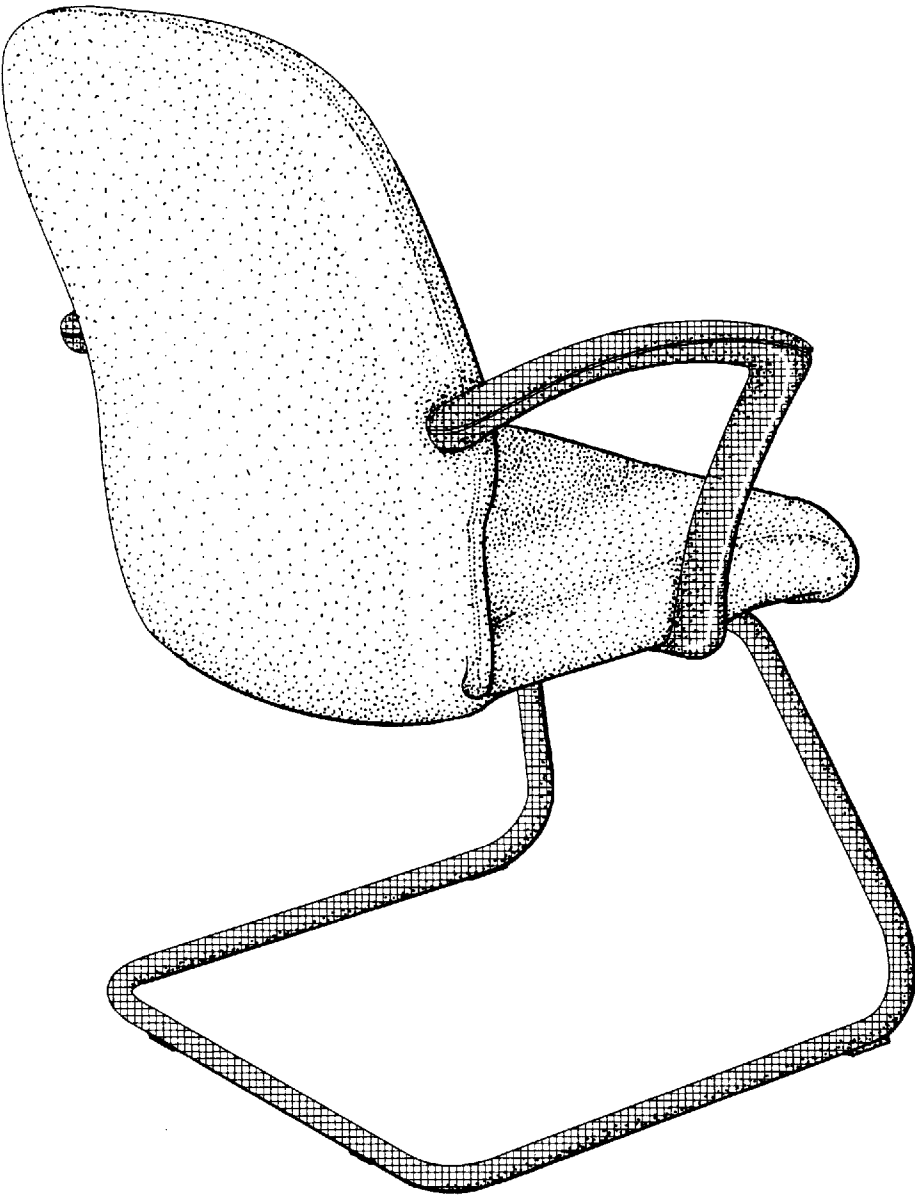
