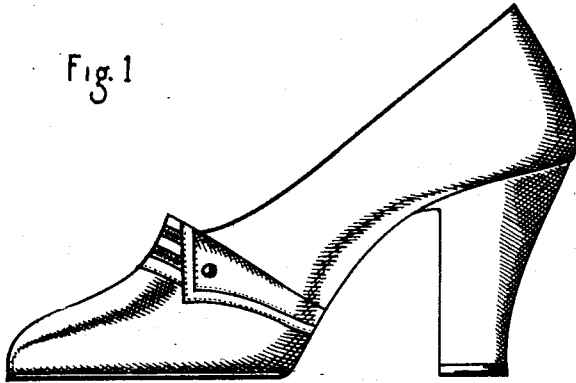
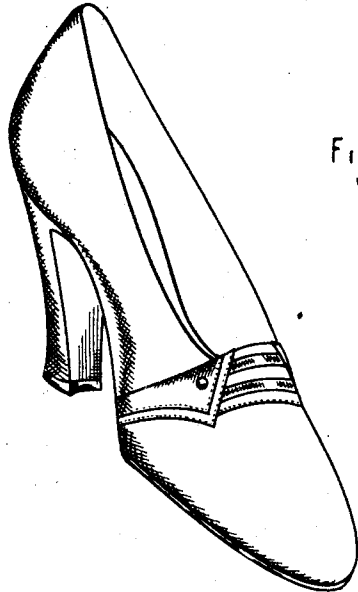

DESIGN FOR A SHOE

Application filed February 5, 1932. Serial No. 42,747. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:
