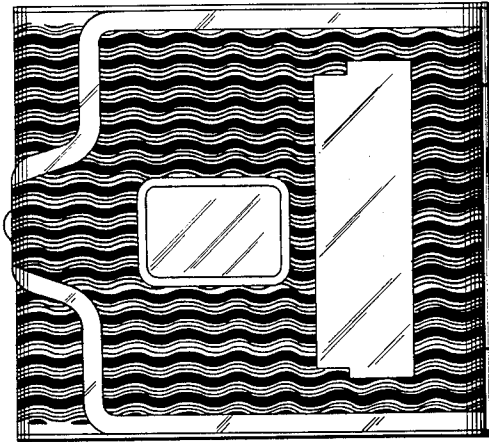

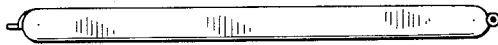

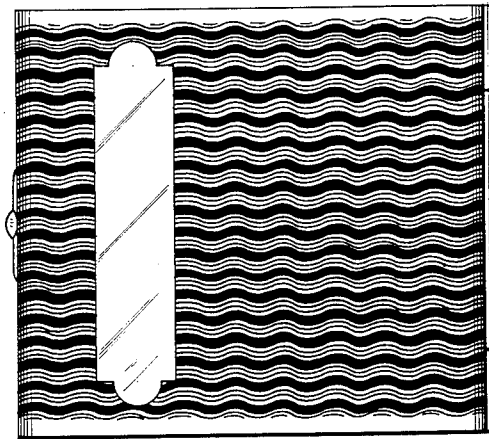

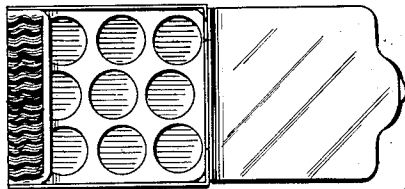

DESIGN FOR A POCKET CASE FOR TABLETS

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Erich Neumann-Holste, a citizen of the Republic of Germany, residing at Bielefeld, State of Prussia, Germany, whose post-office address is Sudbrackstrasse, Bielefeld, Germany, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pocket Case for Tablets, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front view of the pocket case showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side view of the same;

Fig. 3 is a rear view of the pocket case; and

Fig. 4 is an inside view thereof.
