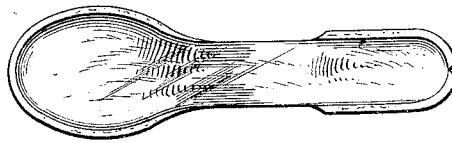
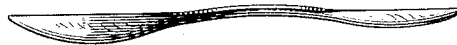

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, BONIFACE A. GRASBERGER, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Richmond, in the county of Henrico and State of Virginia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Single-Service Wooden Spoon, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
