is a mirror image to a right side view;

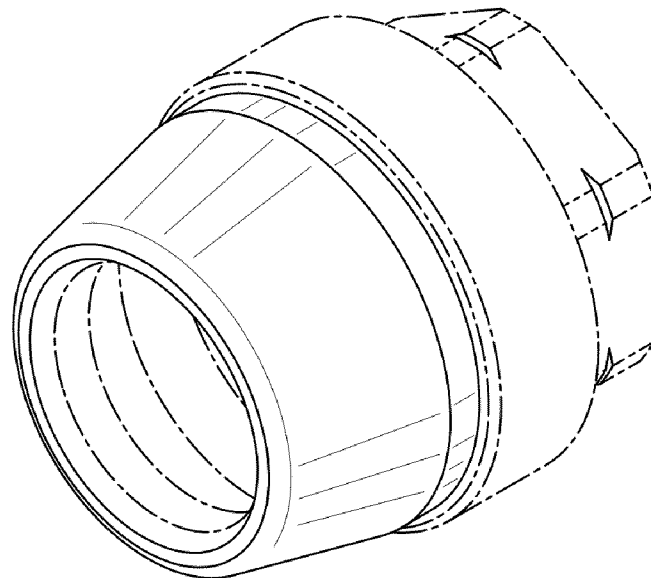
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof, the claimed portion of which is a

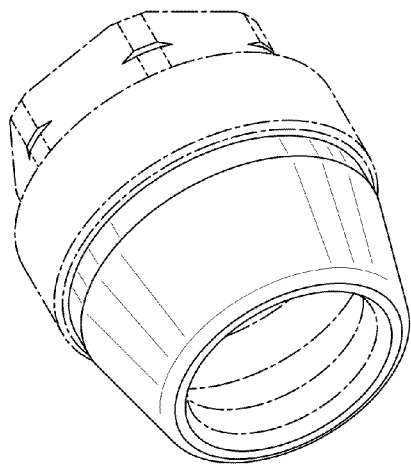

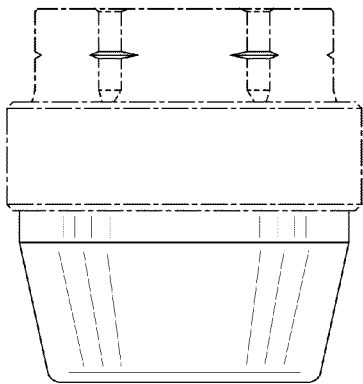

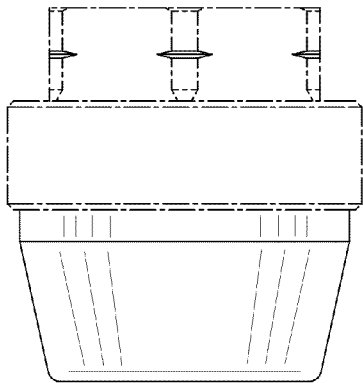

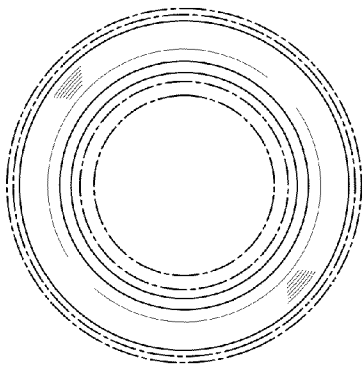

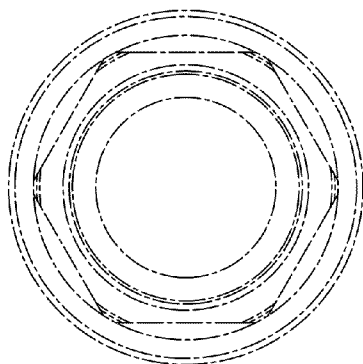
