mounting assembly for electronic devices of FIG. 1;

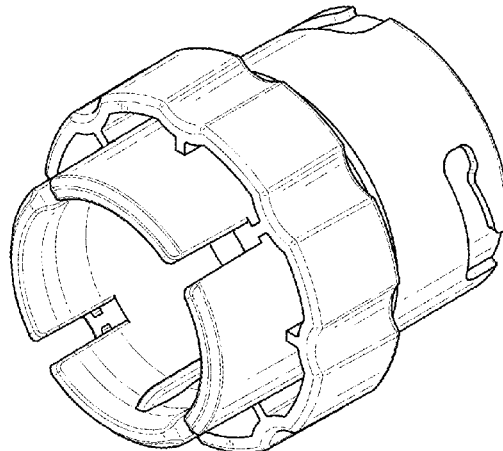
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view of the adapter for a

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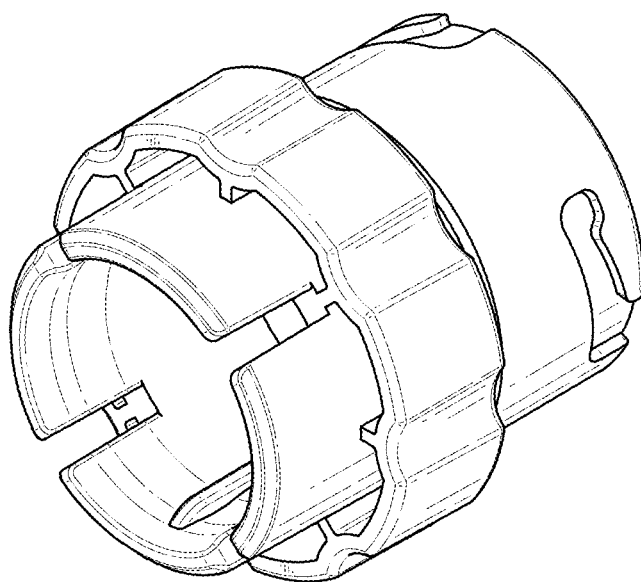

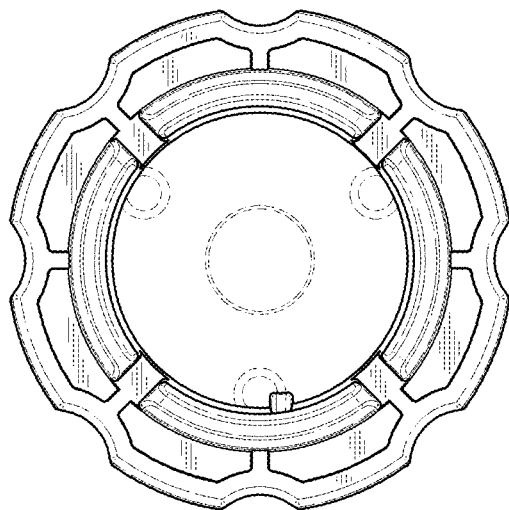

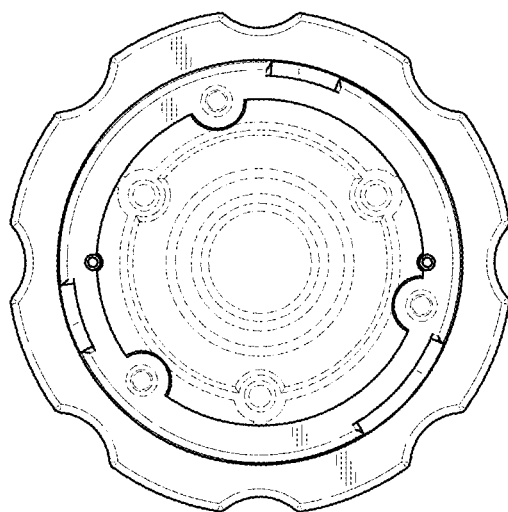

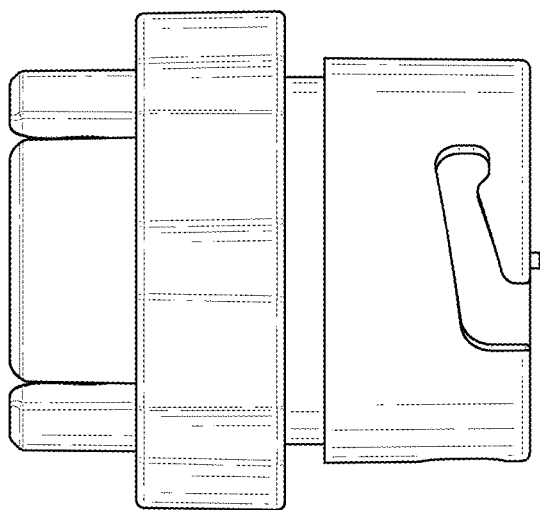

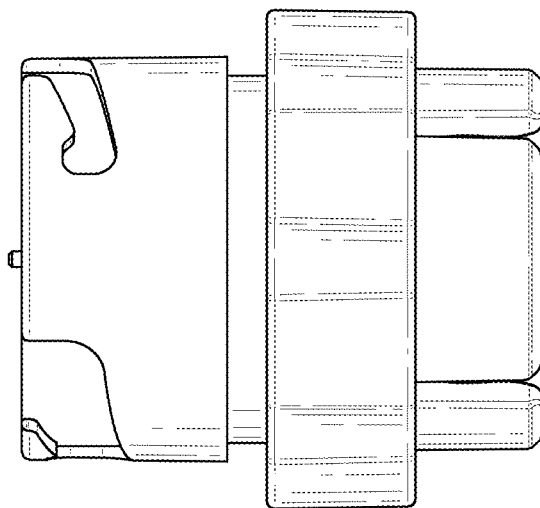

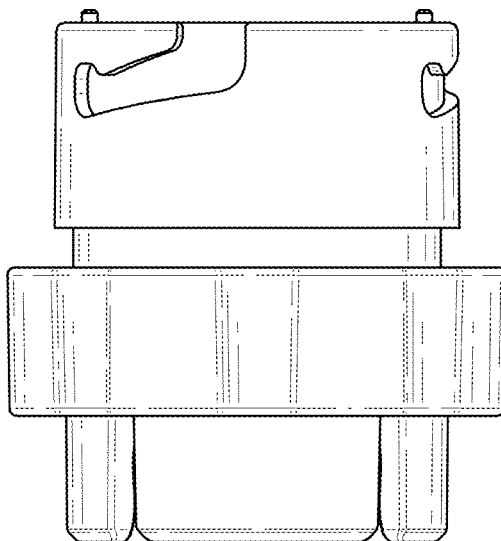

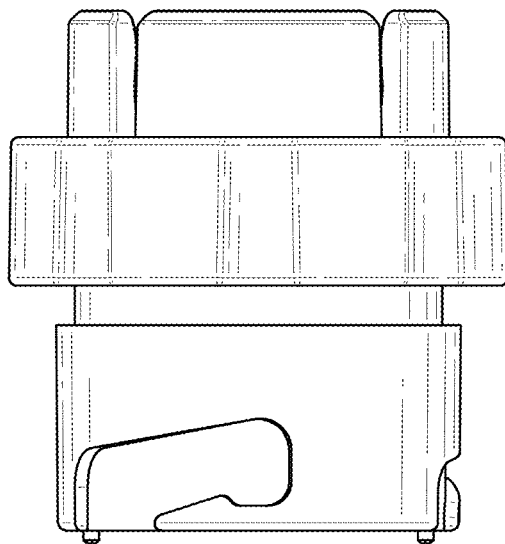
