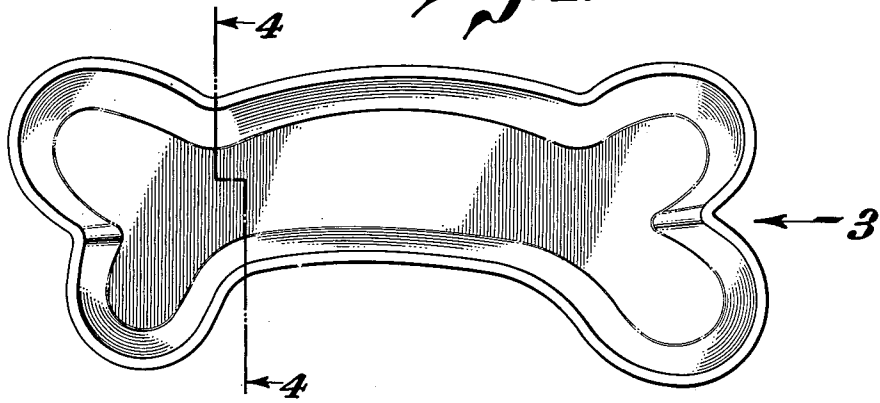


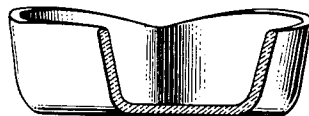

DISH OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Arthur H. Seffin, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Los Angeles, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dish or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a dish embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view;

Fig. 3 is an end elevational view in the direction indicated by the arrow 3 of Fig. 1; and

Fig. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on the line 4—4 of Fig. 1.
