

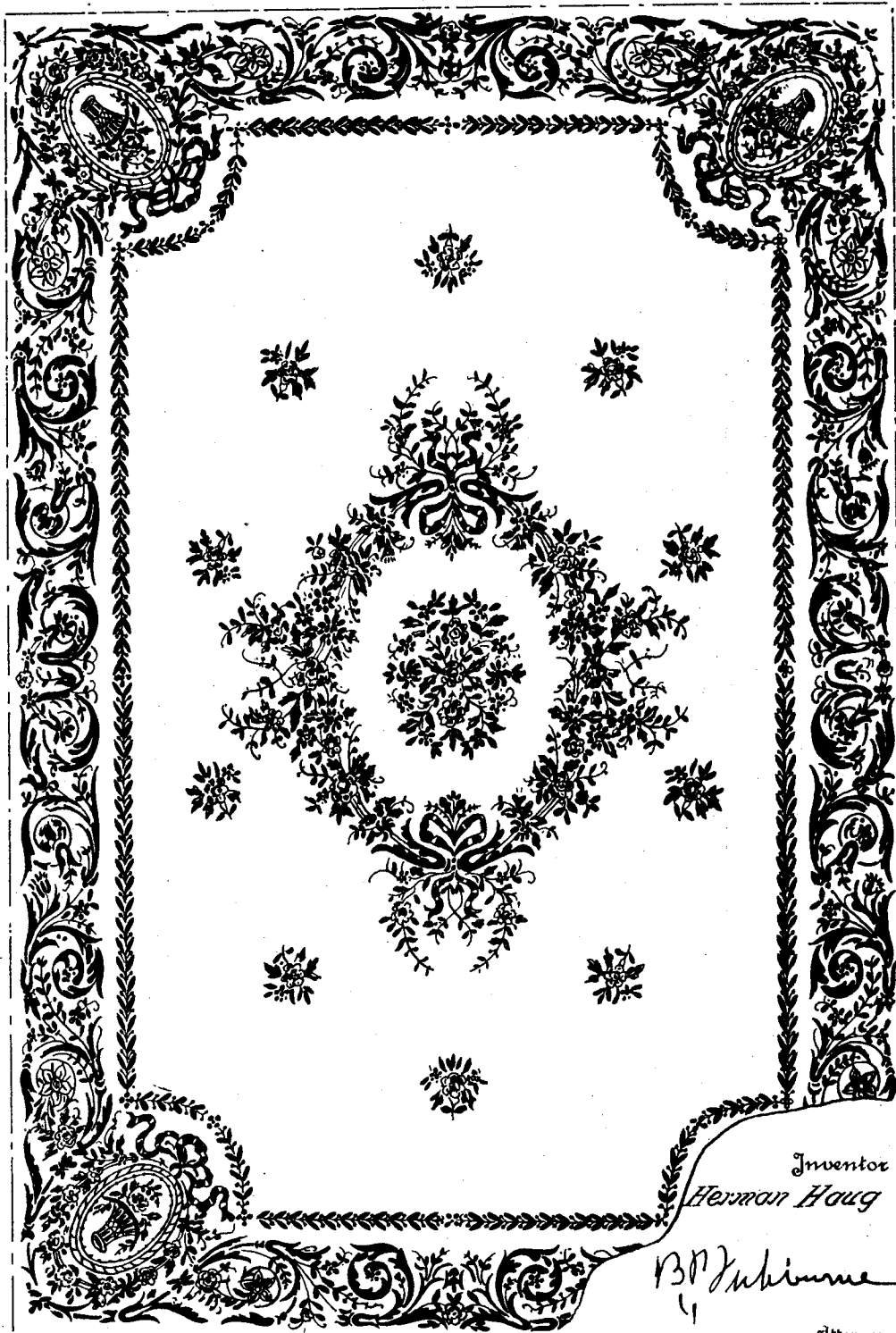

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC.

To all whom it may concern:
