

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ludwig Stark, a citizen of the United States, residing in Springfield, Union County, New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Artificial Christmas Tree, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.
