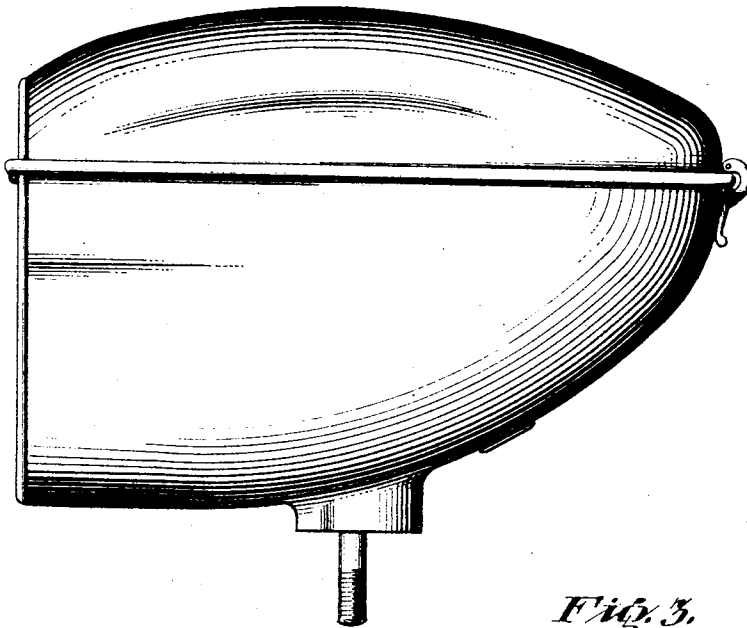

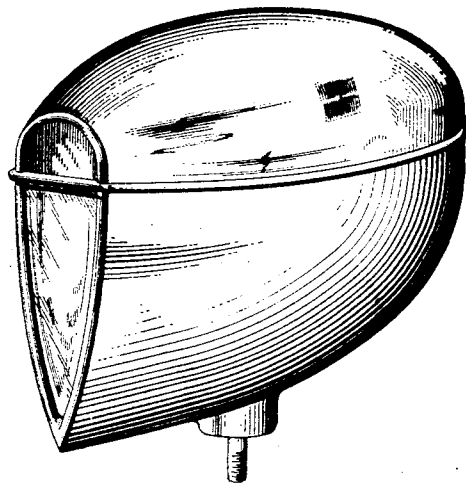
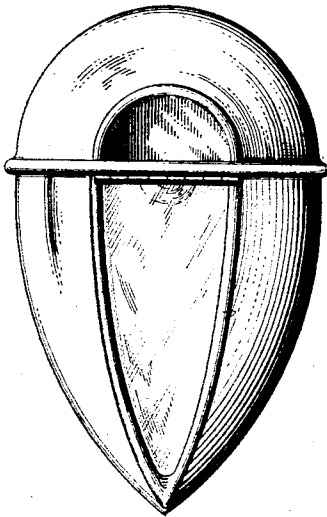

DESIGN FOR A HEADLIGHT.

Application filed March 30, 1926. Serial No. 17,123. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM G. WOOD, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for a Headlight, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
