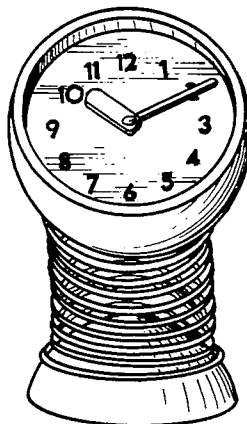
The ornamental design for a clock, as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation thereof, the opposite side is a mirror image.



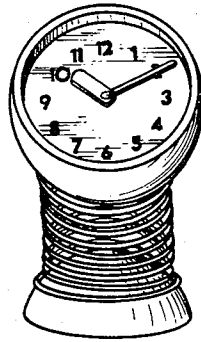

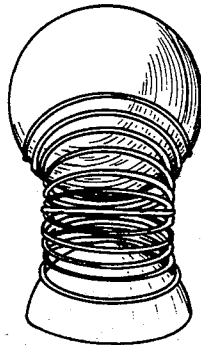

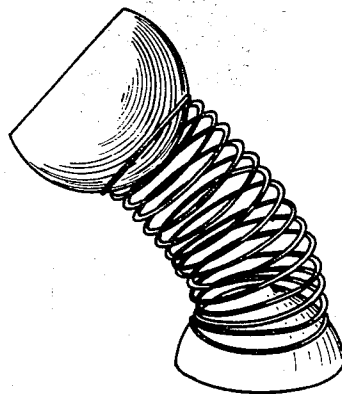
