
(57) **CLAIM**

described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sport bottle cap, showing my  
new design;  
FIG. 2 is a left view the right side view being a mirror image  
thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; and,  
FIG. 5 is a front view thereof, shown in use on a bottle that  
forms no part of the claim.  
The broken lines shown in FIG. 5 represent the portions of a  
sport bottle which form no part of the claimed design.










