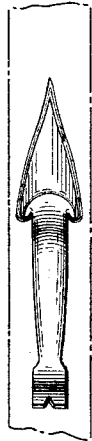
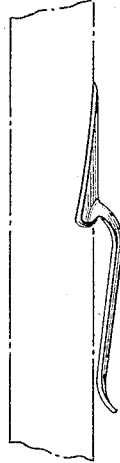

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES R. KEERAN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Clips, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a clip

showing my new design, and attached to the body of a pen, pencil, or the like; and Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof.
