

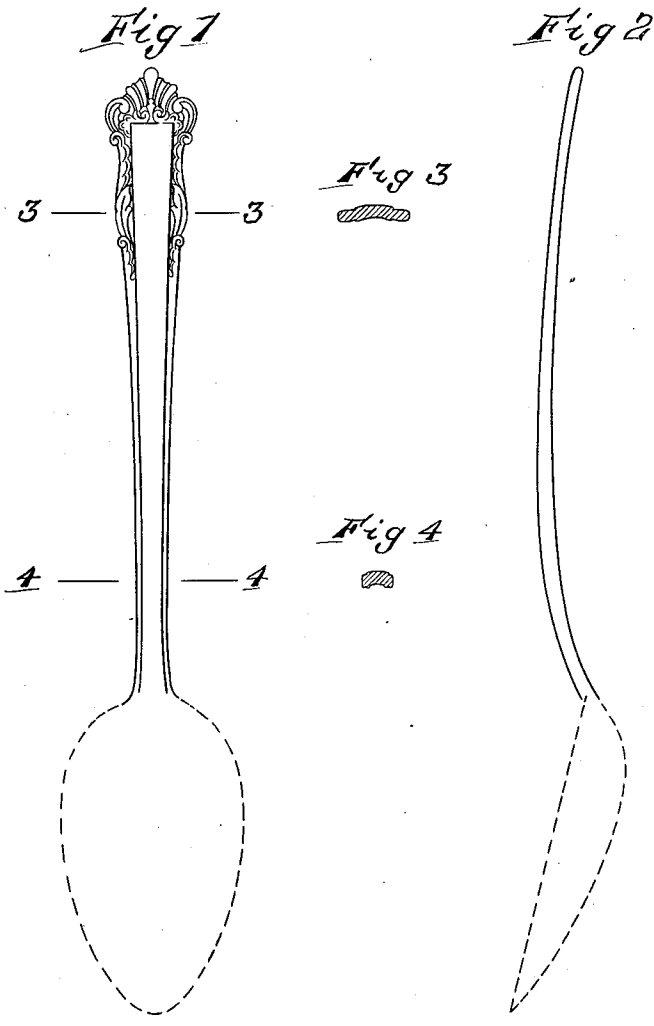

DESIGN FOR A SPOON OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Frederick W. Koonz, Bernardston, Mass., assignor to Rogers, Lunt & Bowlen Company, Greenfield, Mass., a corporation of Massachusetts

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Frederick W. Koonz, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Bernardston, in the county of Franklin and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Spoon or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In said drawing:

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a spoon showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is an edge view looking to the left of Fig. 1; and

Figs. 3 and 4 are sections taken at lines 3—3 and 4—4, respectively of Fig. 1.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a spoon or similar article, substantially as shown.
