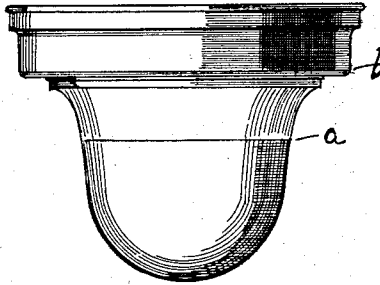
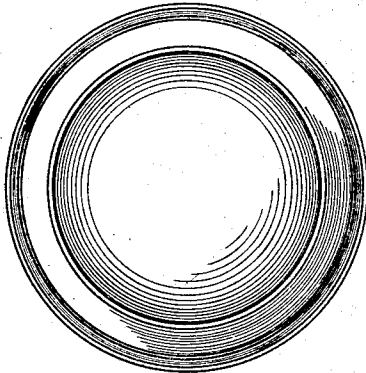

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, RAYMOND V. OWEN, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at the city of St. Louis, State of Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lighting-Fixtures, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side view and Fig. 2 a plan view showing my new design.

The portion of the light shade or shield below the line *a* is translucent and the portion above the line *a* extending to the reflector *b* is transparent.

I claim:

The ornamental design for lighting fixture, as shown and described.
