

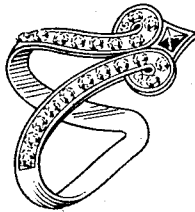

DESIGN FOR A FINGER RING.

Application filed July 22, 1926. Serial No. 18,451. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:
