DESCRIPTION

The ornamental design for a re-freezable cooling cartridge

for drinking bottles, as shown and described.

FIG. 9 is a front view of the second embodiment of the cooling cartridge; and,

FIG. 10 is a rear view of the second embodiment of the cooling cartridge.
