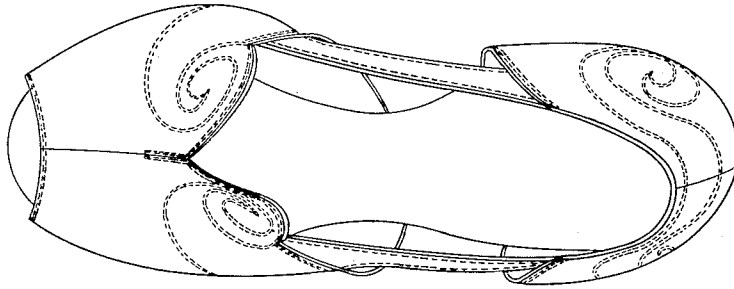
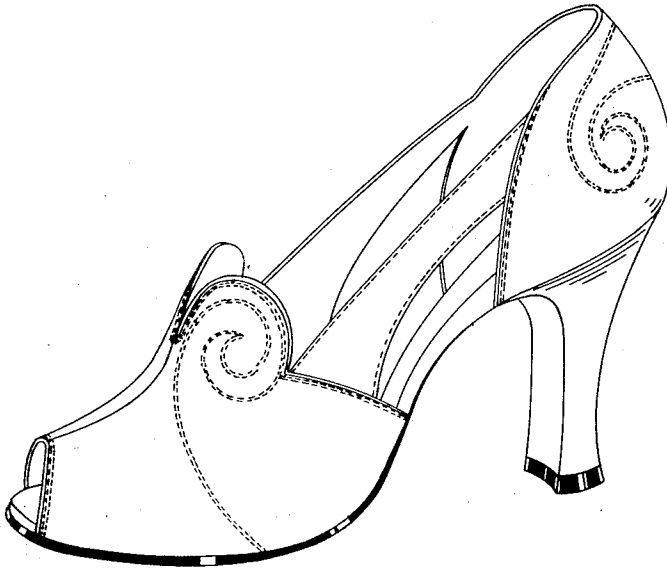

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Leo Sholtz, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York city, in the county of New York, in the State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof:

Figure 1 is a plan view of a shoe showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevation of the shoe, partly in perspective.
