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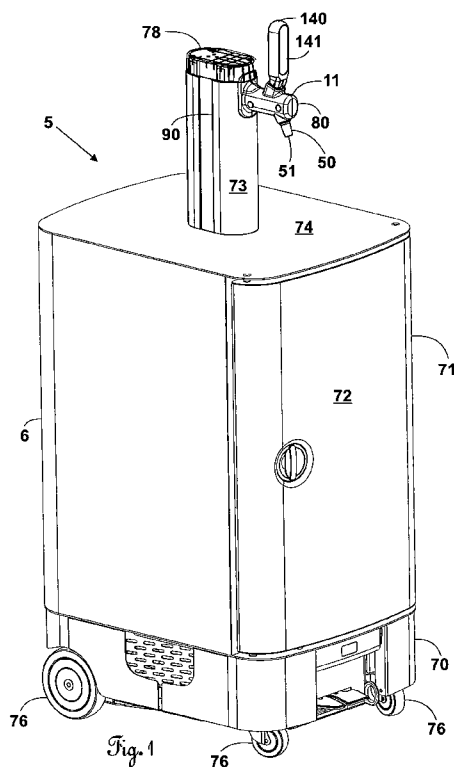
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(54) Title: CREAMY FOAM BEER DISPENSING SYSTEM



(57) Abstract: A creamy foam beer dispensing system includes a coupler removably securable with a keg, a transportation tube, and a faucet. The transportation tube first end engageable with the coupler, whereby beer flows from the keg through the transportation tube. The transportation tube includes a second end engageable with the faucet that includes a compression tube receiver to receive the second end of the transportation tube to deliver beer from the faucet that includes a plunger coupled to a handle movable among closed, open and creamy foam positions.
