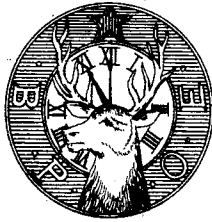

DESIGN FOR A BADGE.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FREDERICK HUGHES, a citizen of the United States, residing at Yonkers, in the county of Westchester and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Badges, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a face view of a badge, showing my new design, which comprises as salient features an annular band encircling

a clock face, the hands pointing to eleven o'clock, and having an elk's head upon the band and clock face, and a star upon the band above the head.
