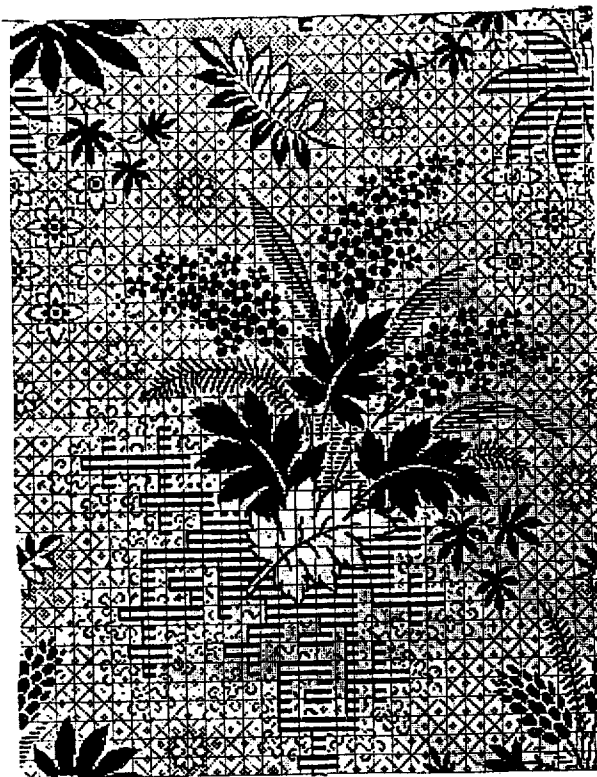

## DESIGN FOR A CARPET.
