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LACK OF UNITY OF INVENTION

The Search Division considers that the present European patent application does not comply with the requirements of unity of invention and relates to several inventions or groups of inventions, namely:

1. claims: 1-7

A trampoline system including a frame or other foundation, a plurality of jumping mats and a first biasing means arranged between the mat and the frame, biasing outwards, a second biasing means arranged between two mats and biasing said mats upwards, and a third biasing means arranged between two mats biasing them towards each other. It solves the problem of providing a multidirectional biasing for the mats.

2. claims: 8-14

A mat connector including a resilient joint support. It solves the problem of increasing the support for the joint.
