



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Paul A. Williams, a citizen of the United States, residing at Ebenezer, county of Erie, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Candles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.
