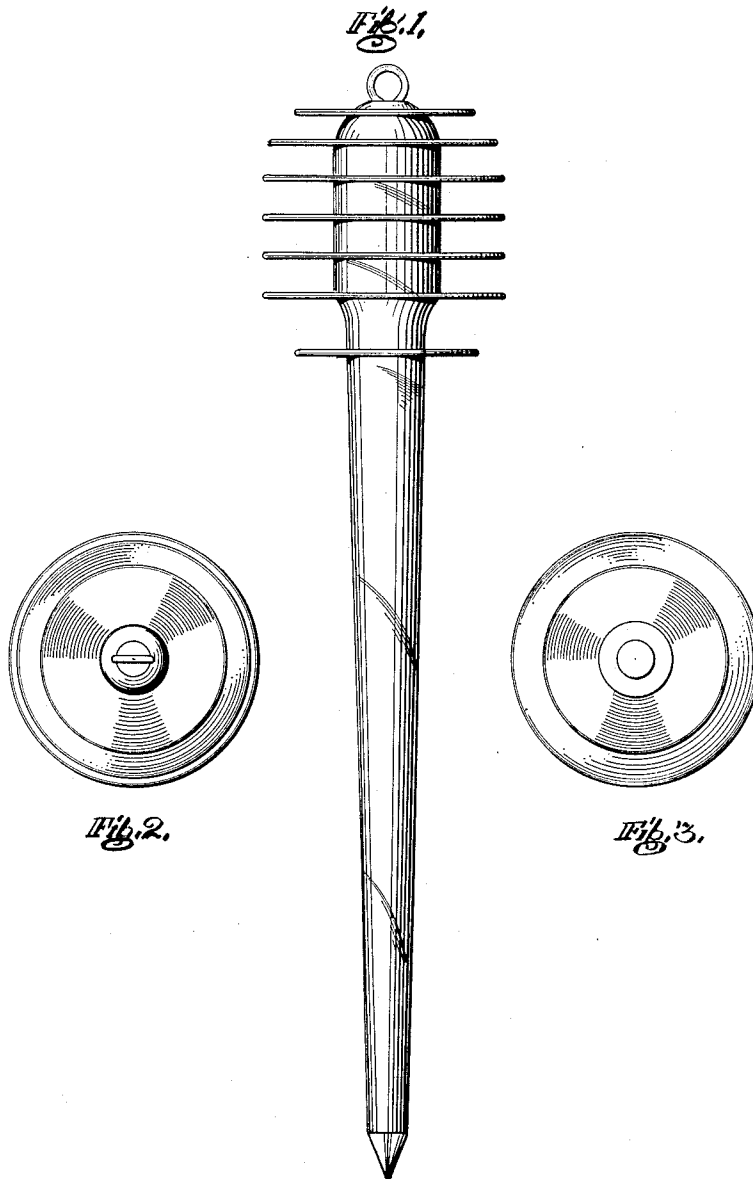
THERMAL PIN FOR MEAT ROASTS

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William Perez, a citizen of the United States, residing at Mineola, county of Nassau, State of New York, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Thermal Pin for Meat Roasts, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a front view of a thermal pin for meat roasts showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top view thereof; and

Fig. 3 is a bottom view thereof.
