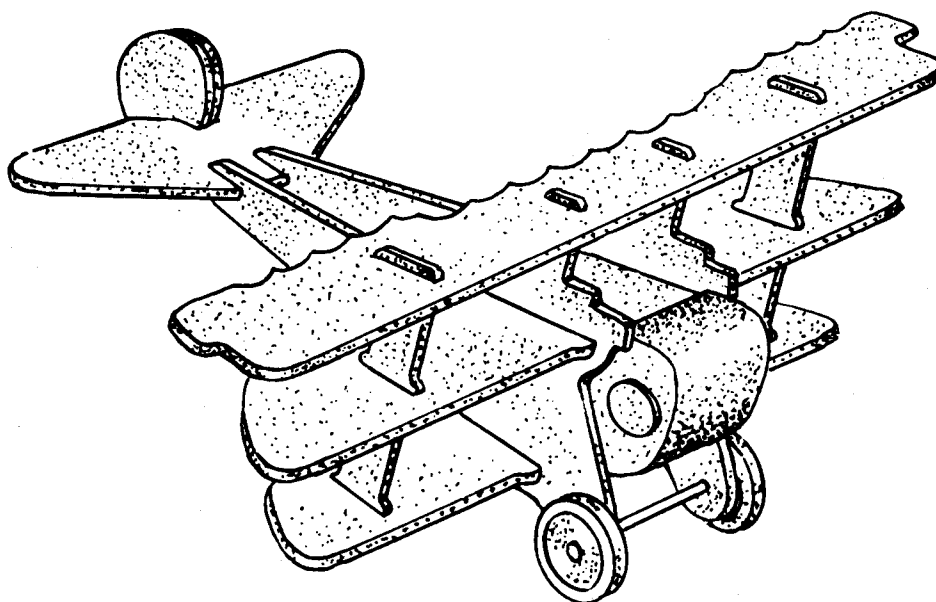

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy airplane illustrating my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;

 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



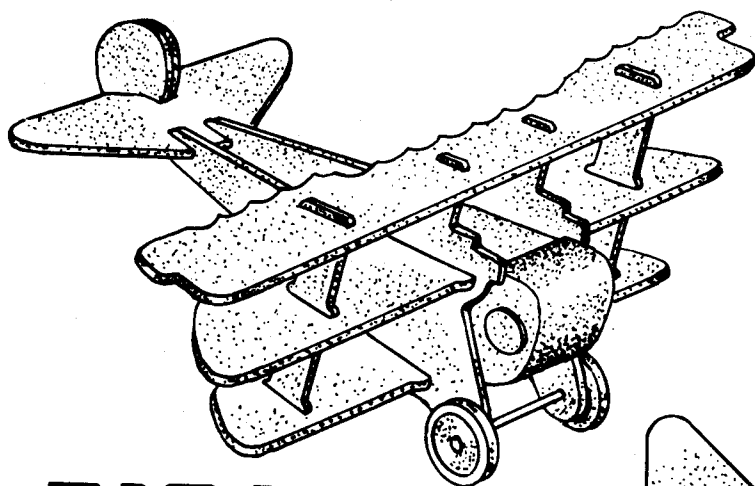

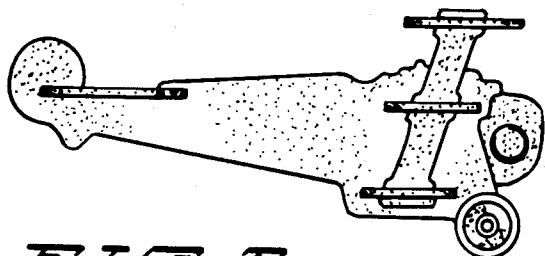
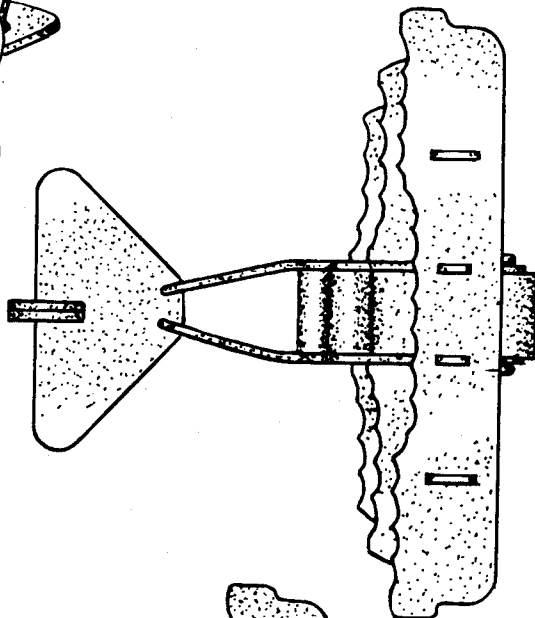

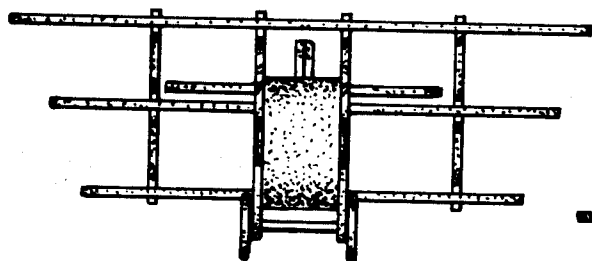
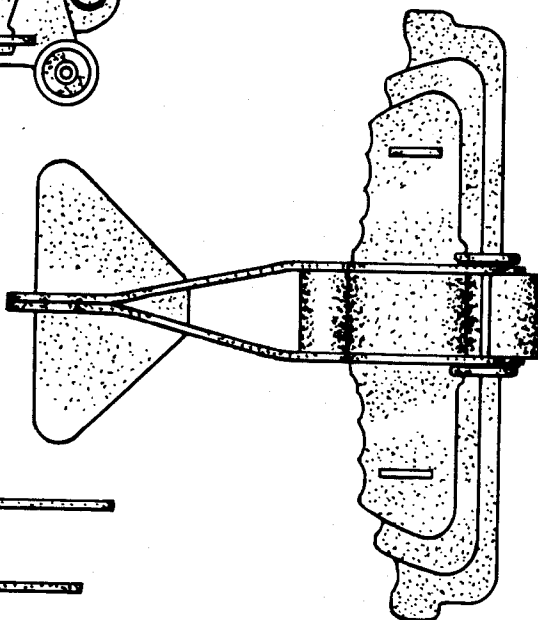

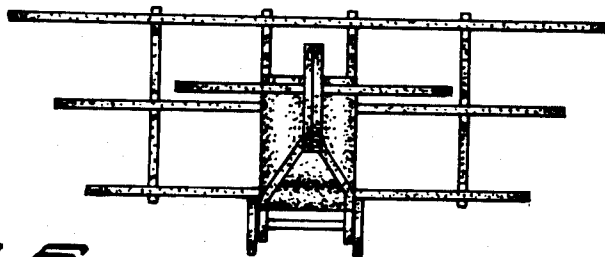
