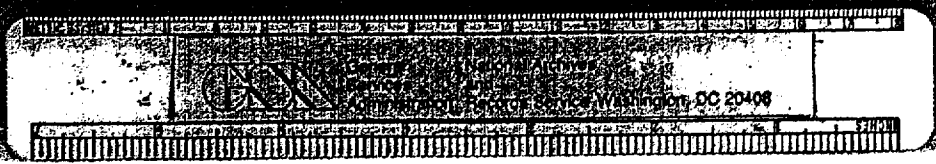

DESIGN FOR A BARN-DOOR HANGER OR ROLLER.
