### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a knife, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a knife according to the present invention;  
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of a first side of the knife of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 3 is a left end view of the knife of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 4 is a right end view of the knife of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the knife of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the knife of FIG. 1 showing the side opposite to that depicted in FIG. 2; and,  
 FIG. 7 is a view of the knife of FIG. 2 but showing the knife in a folded configuration.












