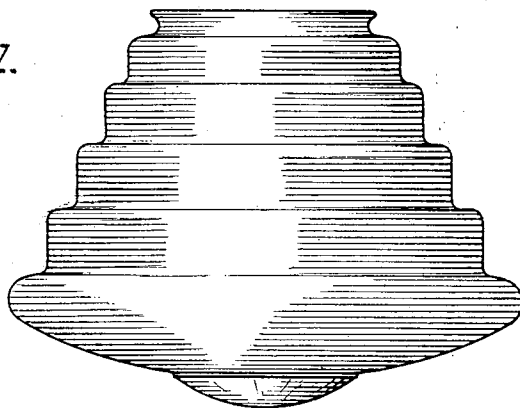
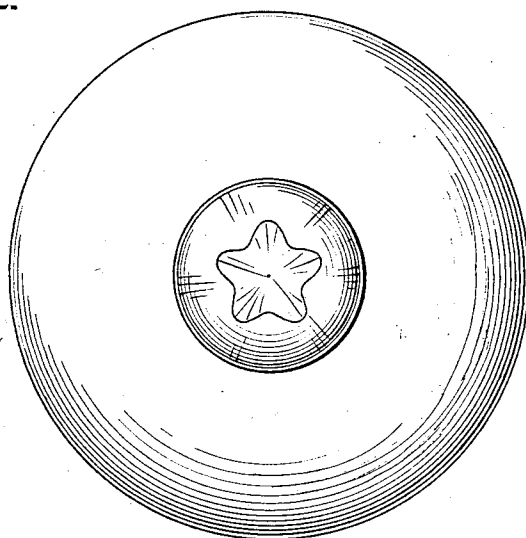

### DESIGN FOR A GLOBE FOR INCLOSED LIGHTING UNITS

Application filed September 9, 1930. Serial No. 36,918. Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, PETER PARLATO, a citizen of the United States of America, and a resident of Astoria, county of Queens, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Globes for Inclosed Lighting Units, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of the globe for inclosed lighting units; and

Figure 2 is an inverted plan view of the same.
