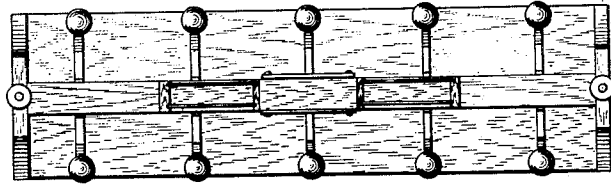

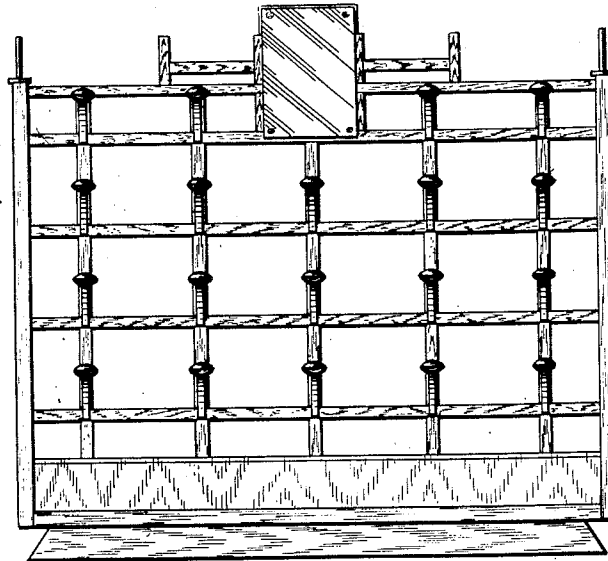
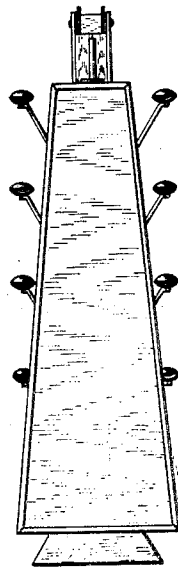

DESIGN FOR A HAT RACK

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Herbert B. Beidler, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Hat Rack, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a top plan view of the hat rack, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the hat

rack illustrated in Figure 1, the opposite side of the hat rack being exactly the same as the view of Figure 2; and

Figure 3 is an end elevational view of one end of the hat rack shown in Figures 1 and 2, the opposite end of the hat rack being the same as the view shown in this figure.
