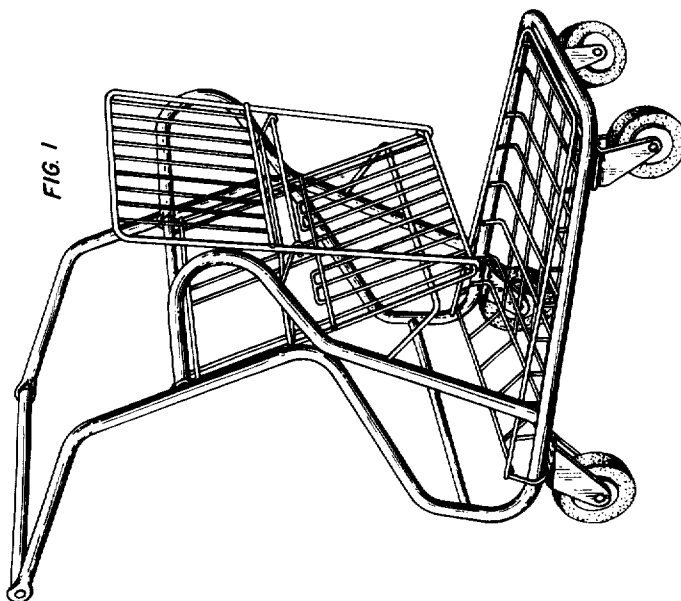
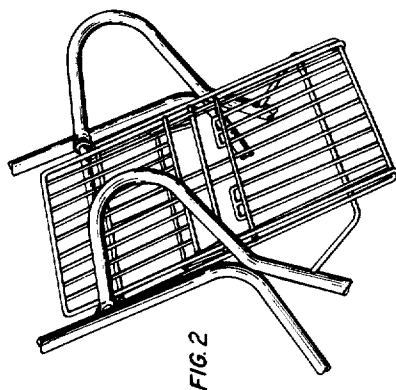


FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a nestable stroller showing my new design; and
