DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole showing my
new design, the top plan view being substantially flat
and unornamented;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing of a shoe upper in FIG. 2 is for
illustrative purposes and forms no part of the claimed
design.

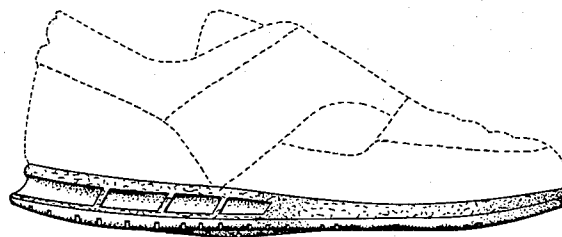
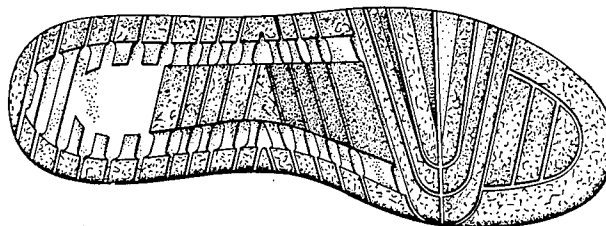

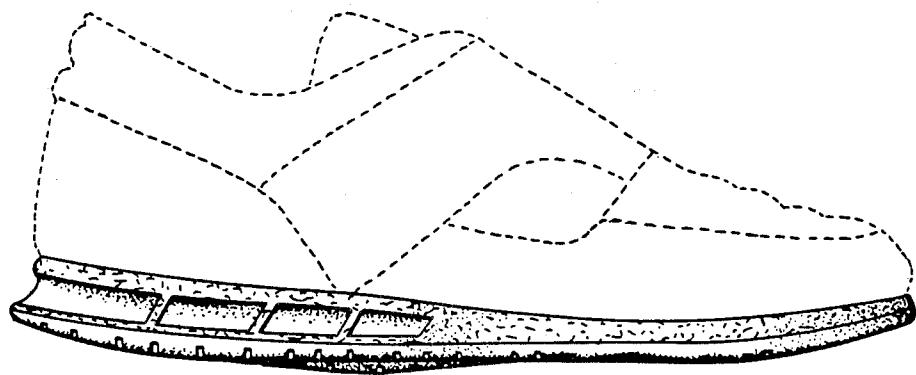
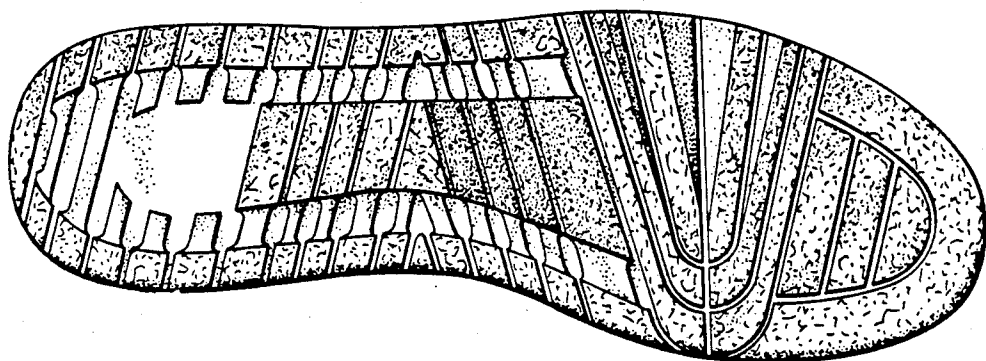

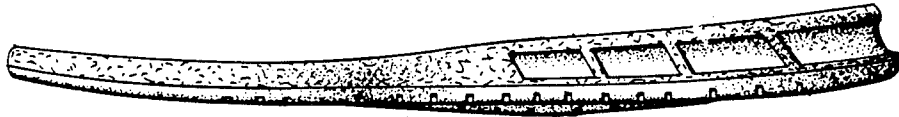

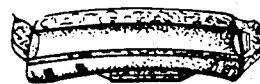
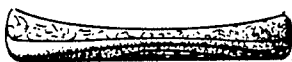
