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(54) Title: ACETAMINOPHEN PHARMACEUTICAL COMPOSITIONS

(57) Abstract: Modified release dosage forms for daily oral dosing to a human patient for providing relief from pain are provided. The modified release dosage form comprises an immediate release component and a sustained release component, wherein the immediate release component and the sustained release component collectively contain a therapeutically effective amount of acetaminophen and an optional therapeutically effective amount of active pharmaceutical ingredient such as an opioid or opioid-like analgesic. In one embodiment, the opioid or opioid-like analgesic is propoxyphene napsylate or propoxyphene HCl salt.
