

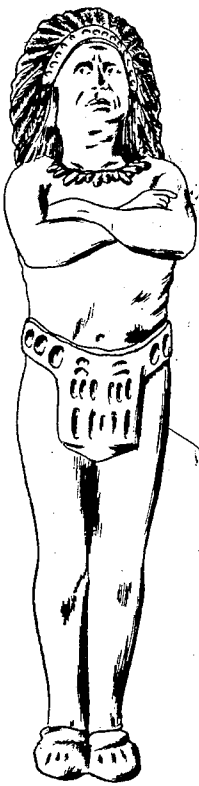

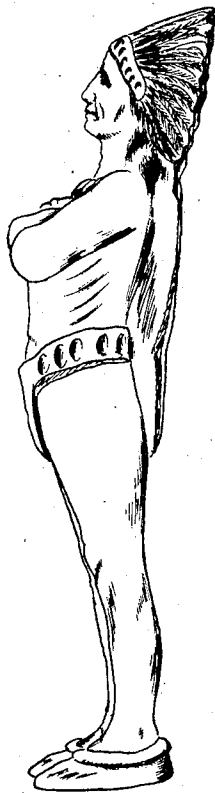

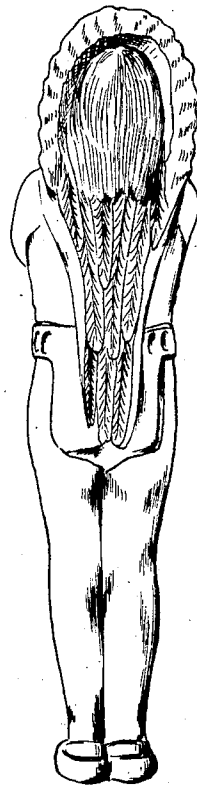

DESIGN FOR A DOLL.

Application filed March 12, 1923. Serial No. 5,441. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, DOMENIC ZAPPIA, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Doll, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing, Fig. 1 is a front elevation of the doll; Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof, and Fig. 3 is a rear elevation.

I claim:
