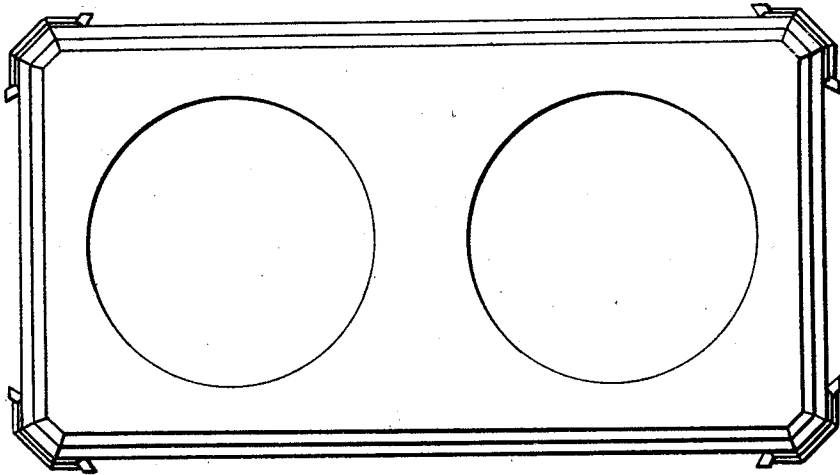

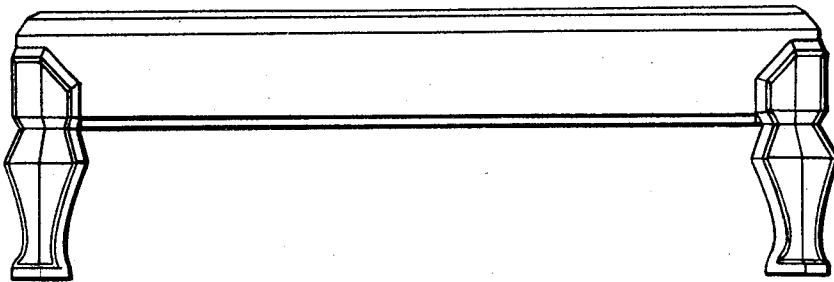
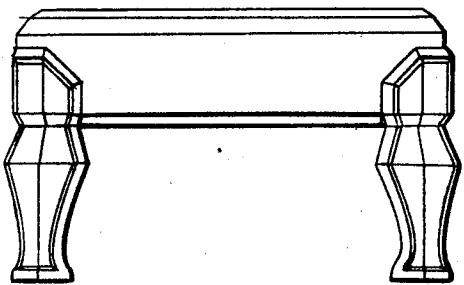

DESIGN FOR AN ELECTRIC HOT PLATE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ABE O. SAMUELS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rochester, in the county of Monroe and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Electric Hot Plate, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of an electric hot plate, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevation of the electric hot plate.

Figure 3 is an end elevation of the electric hot plate.
