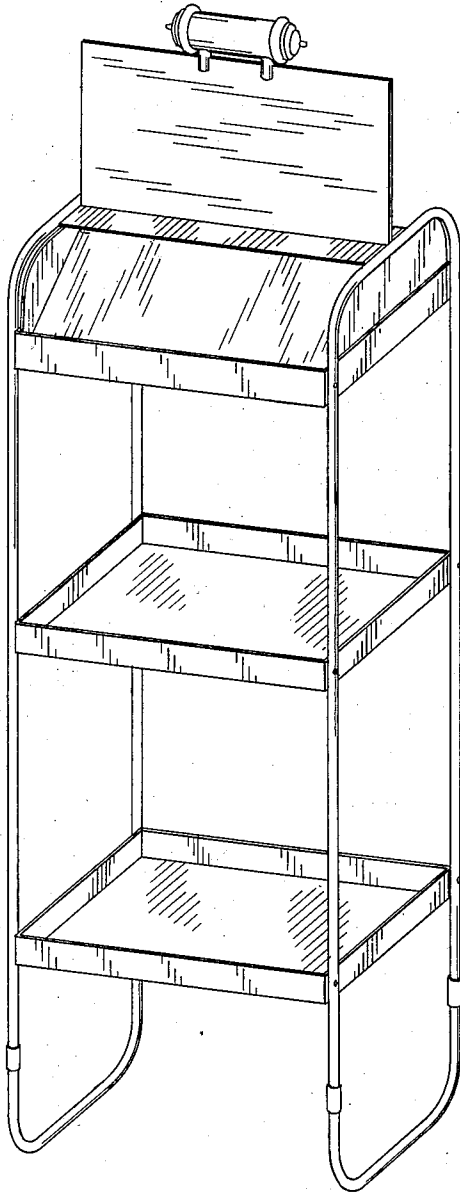
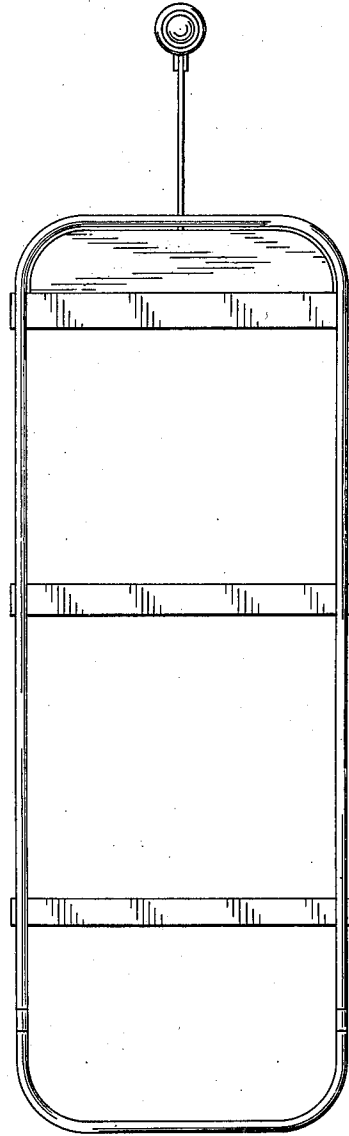

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Chester William Lea, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fairbury, in the county of Jefferson and State of Nebraska, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Display Stand, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
