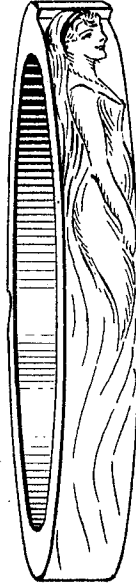

DESIGN FOR A WEDDING RING

Application filed December 21, 1931. Serial No. 42,174. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRED G. DAHLIN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Wedding Ring, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 of the drawings, is a perspective

view of a ring embodying my design, showing one side as it appears from a viewpoint below the ring; and Fig. 2 is a perspective view of the ring, showing the opposite side as it appears from a point below the ring.
