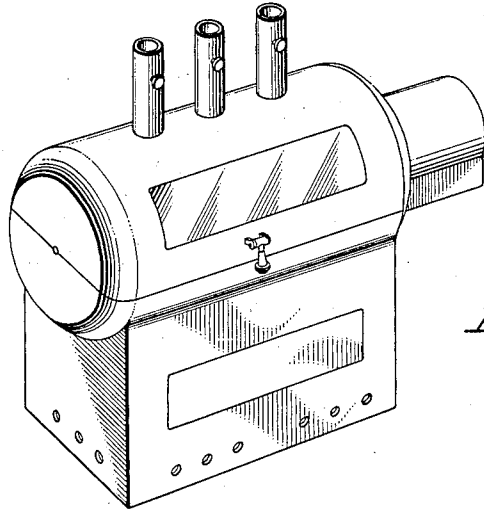

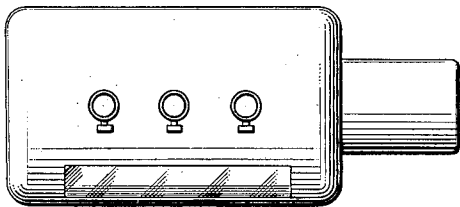

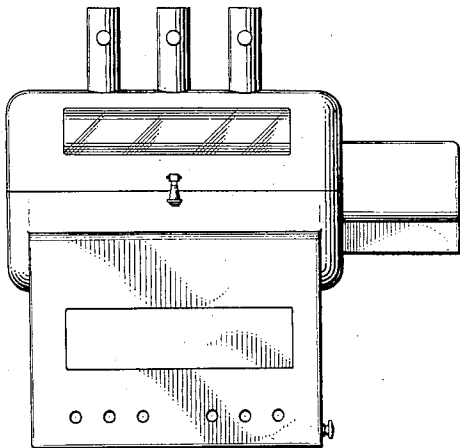

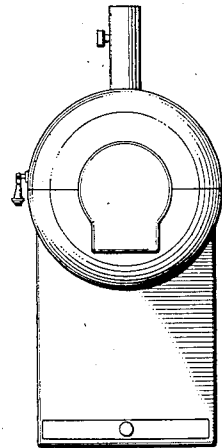

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George D. Eddy, a citizen of the United States and a resident of San Gabriel, county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Roaster and Broiler or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
