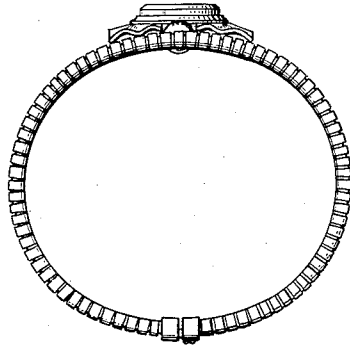

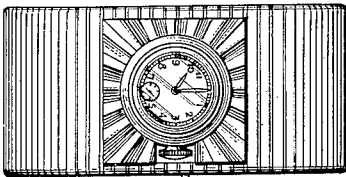

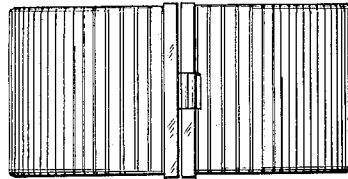
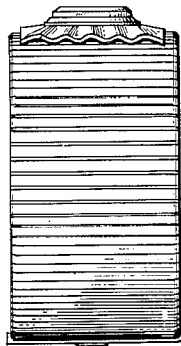

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Max Megur, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of New York, county of Bronx, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Watch and Bracelet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
