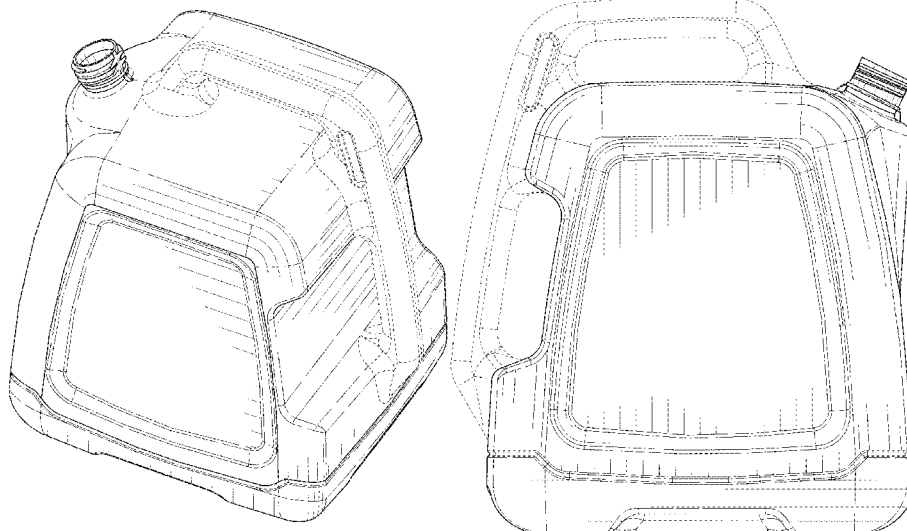
The ornamental design for a portable fuel tank body, as shown and described.

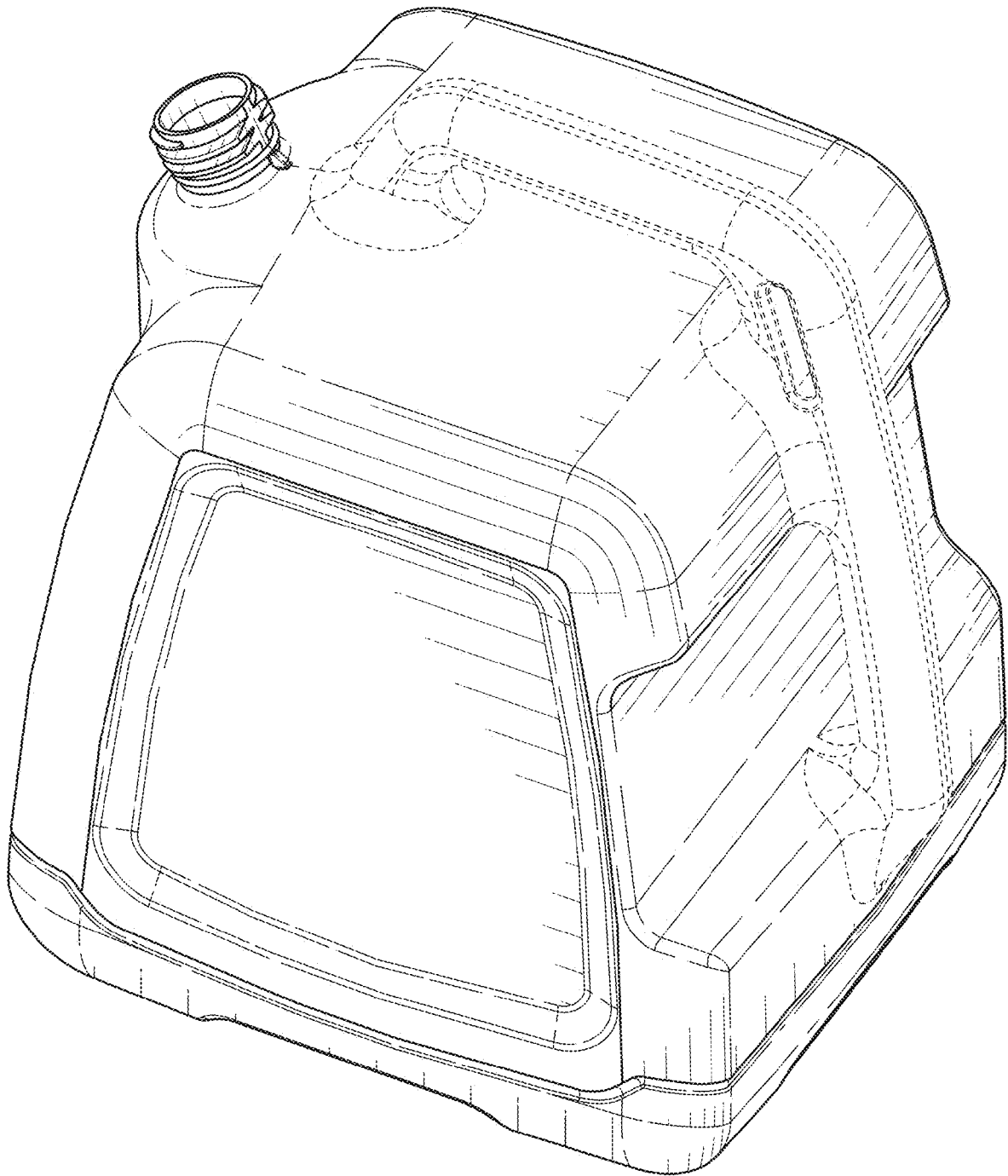

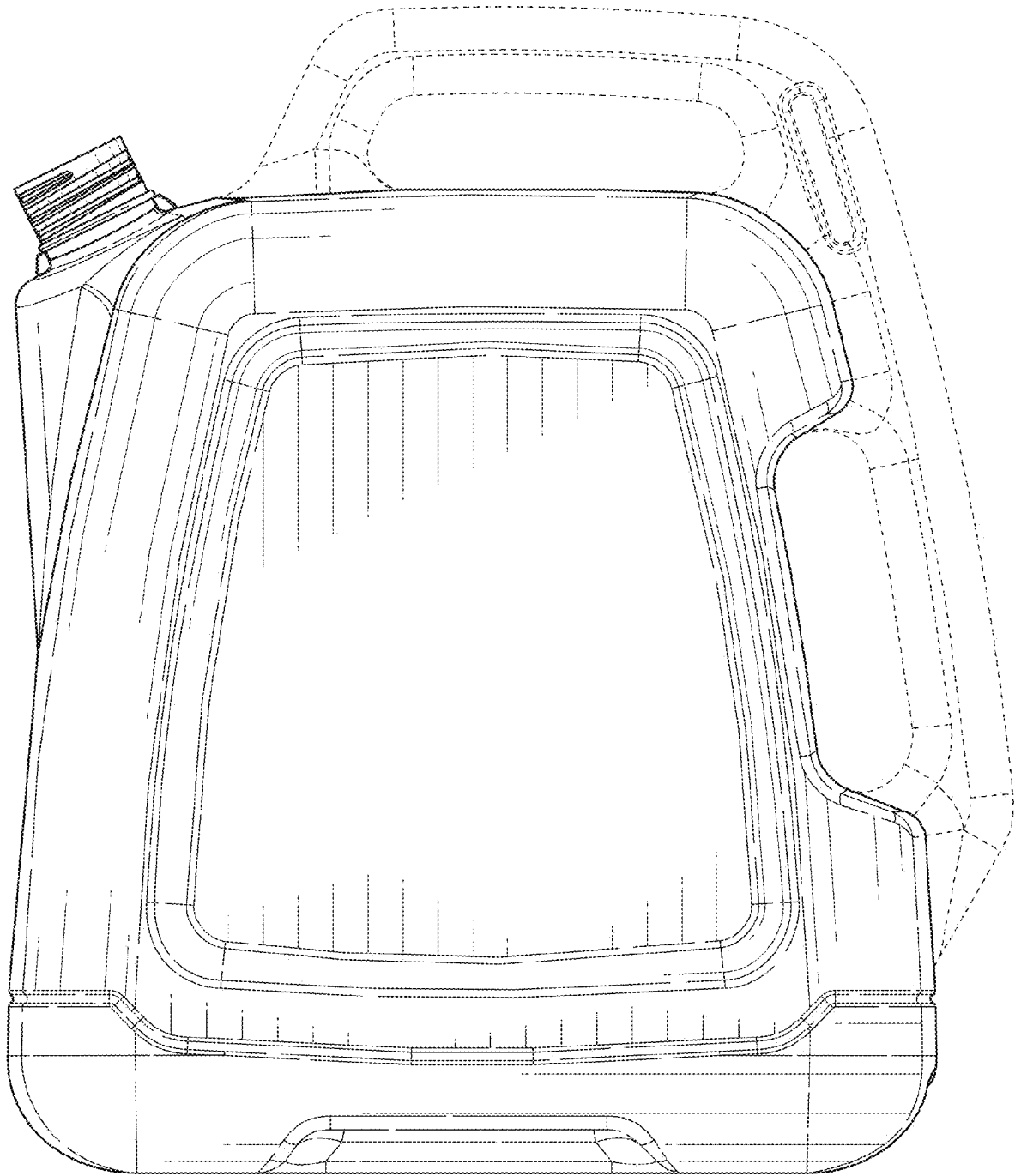

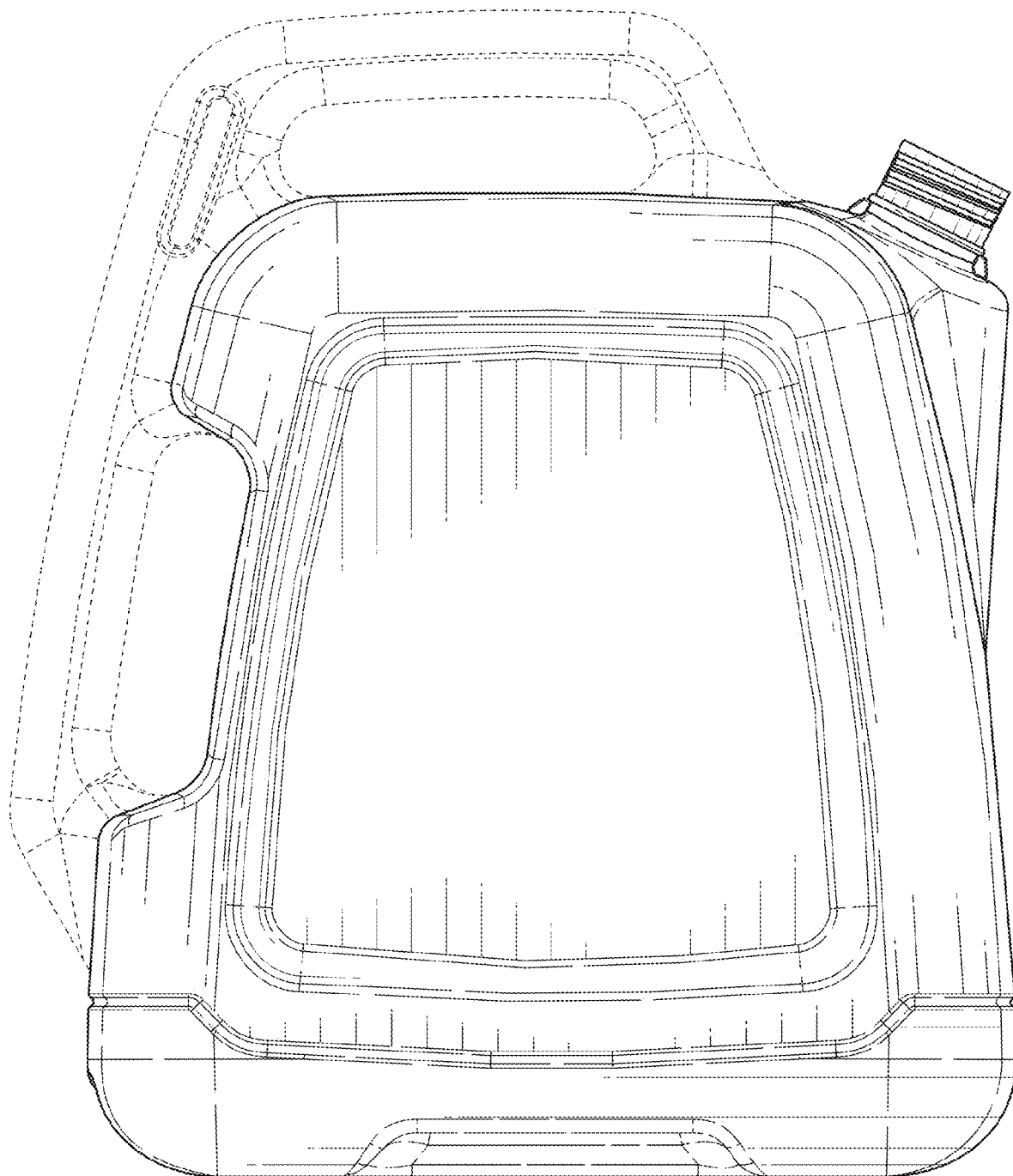

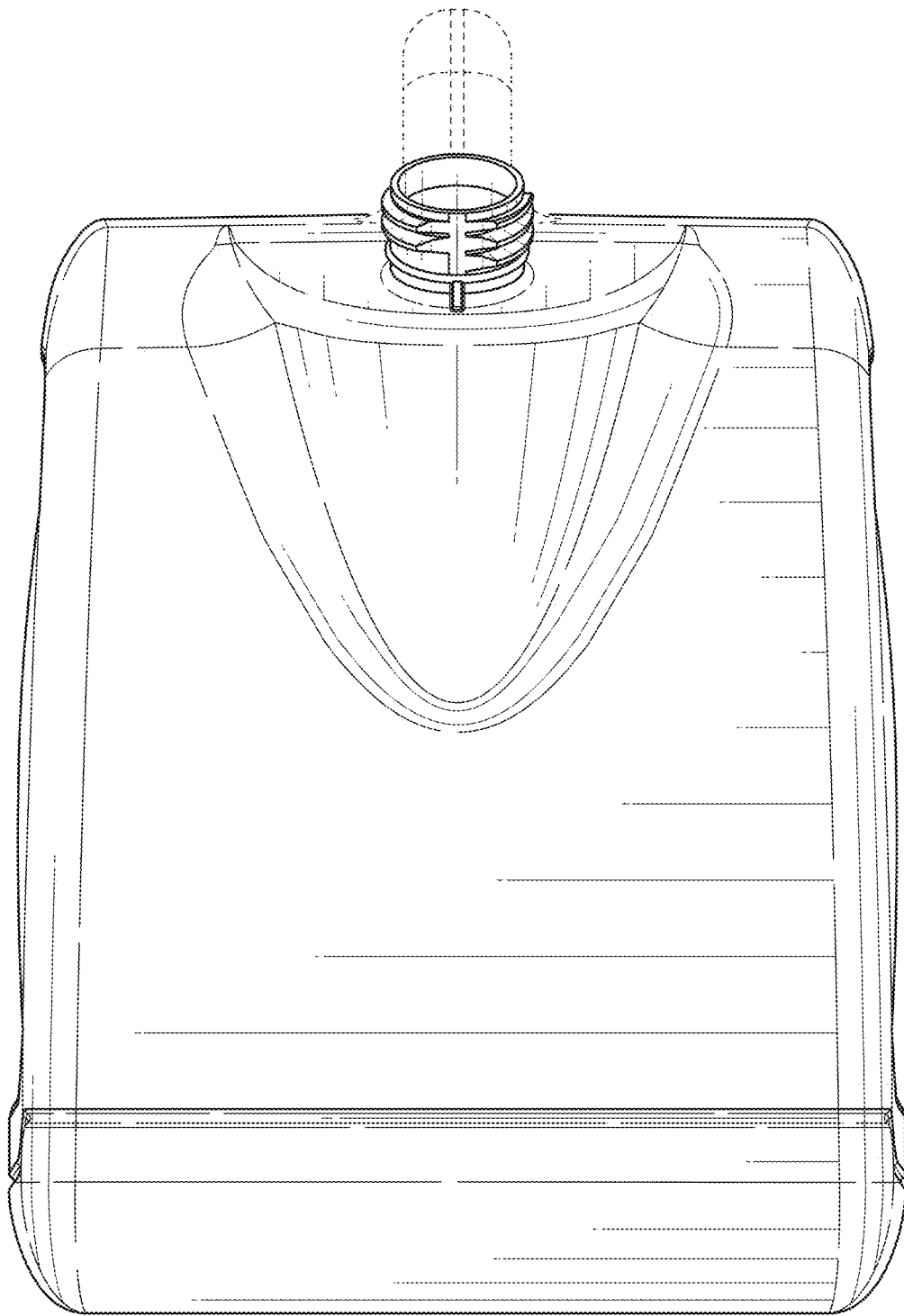

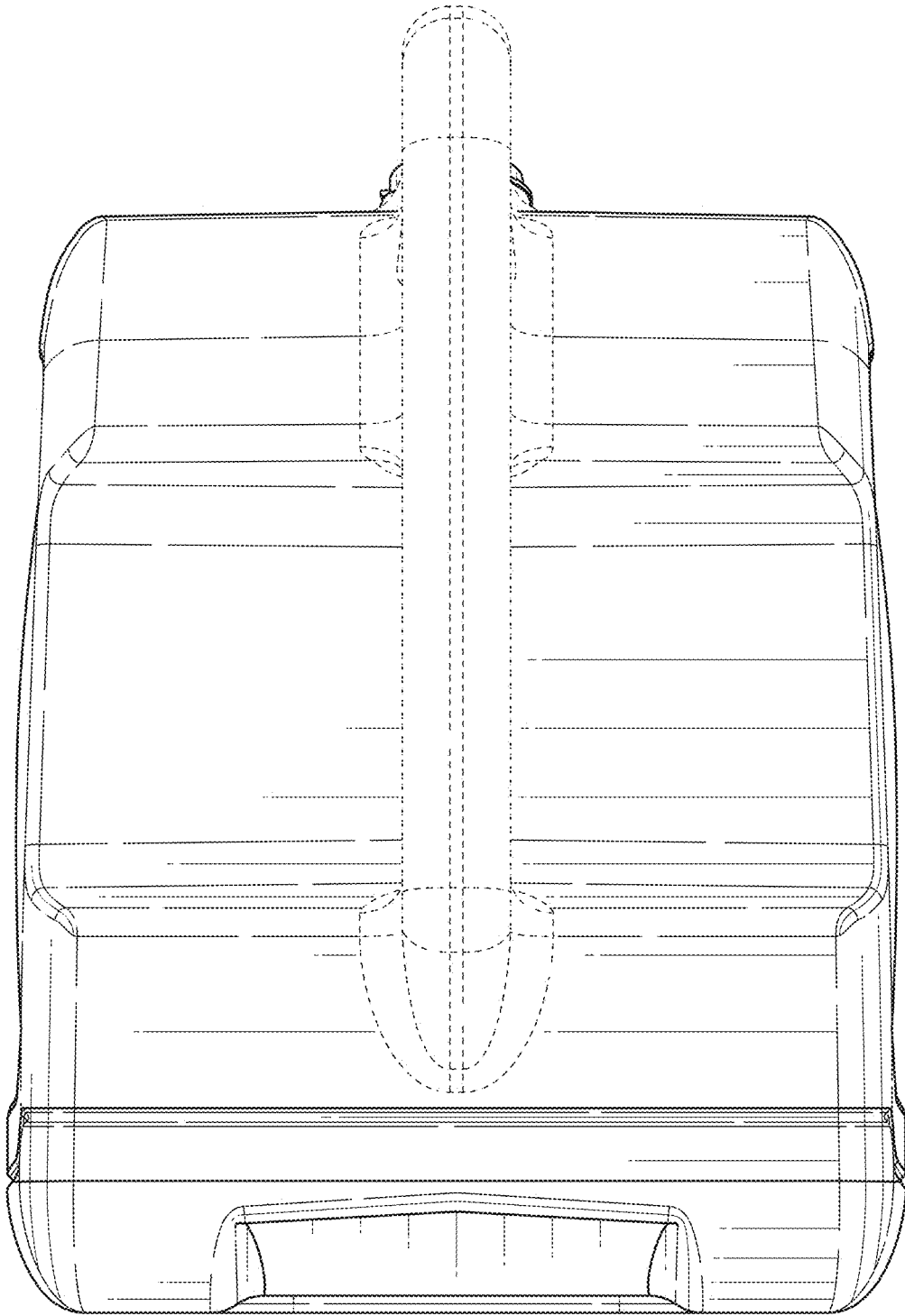

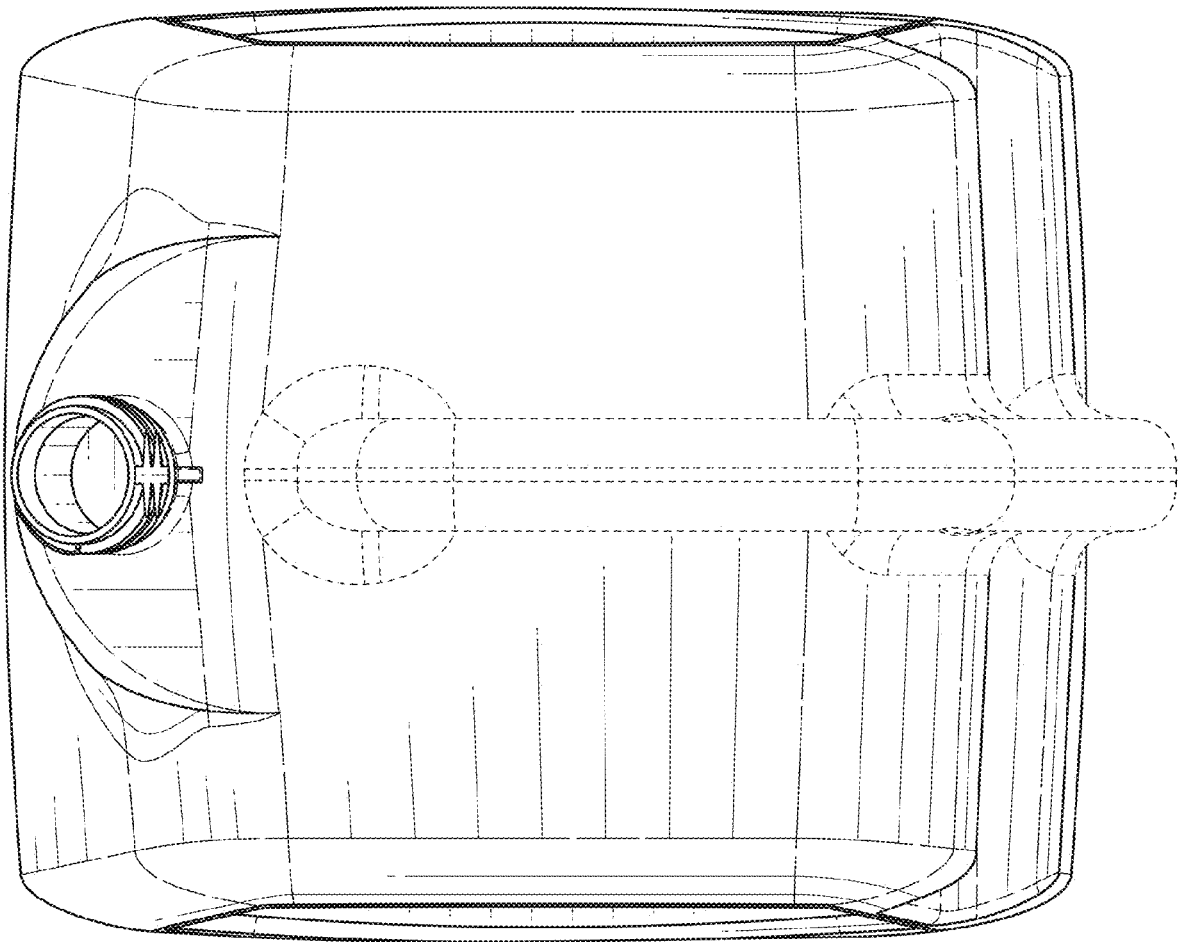

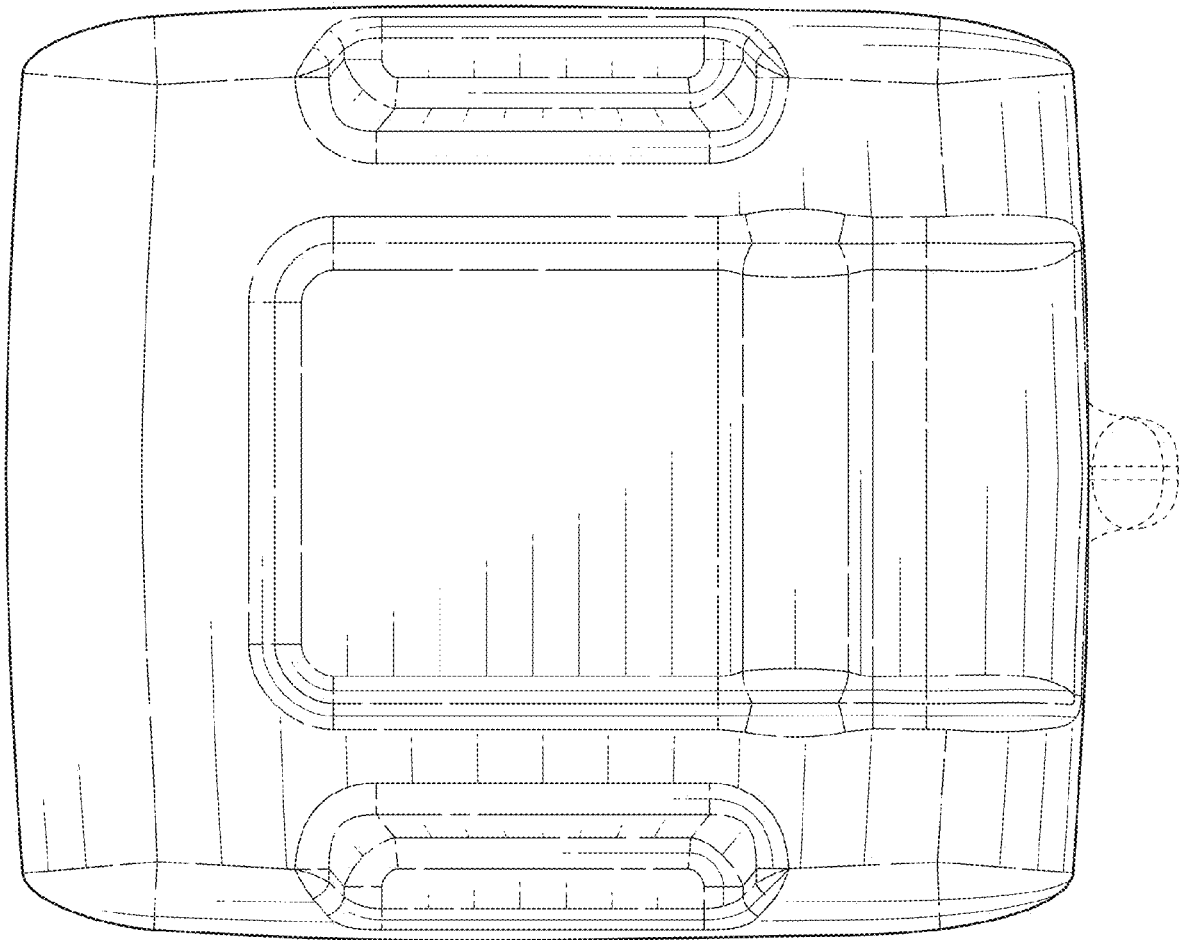
